To the People of God in the Archdiocese of New Orleans:

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

As we approach World Mission Sunday on October 20, 2024, I write to you with a heart full of hope, reflecting on the theme chosen by His Holiness Pope Francis: *"Go and invite everyone to the banquet (cf.
