



Our Lady of Fatima Established—On April 17, 1949, Bishop Jeanmard responded to the growing population of the city of Lafayette by creating the parish of Our Lady of Fatima. It was carved out of the Cathedral, St. Paul, St. Genevieve, Immaculate Heart of Mary, and Our Lady of Wisdom. In less than 10 years, the parish was able to build the current church building which was dedicated in 1958. In time, other parishes would be carved out of Fatima. These include St. Jules, Holy Cross, St. Edmond, and St. Mary.


