Program: Our high school religious education program uses the Life Teen PURPOSE curriculum. The curriculum is based on the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' "National Doctrinal Curriculum Framework for High School Catechesis". The curriculum includes the following topics: Sacred Scripture, Person of Christ, Paschal Mystery, Church, Sacraments, Morality, Social Justice, and Vocations. It is now a combination of high school religious education and a three-year sacramental preparation program. As a result, we now refer to each year as the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd year of Sacramental Preparation for Holy Confirmation.

Attendance:

- Our new high school youth ministry will involve a 3-year program for sacramental prep to better prepare students for their Confirmation and to build a stronger community of faith in the parish.
- Year 1 & Year 2 (typically 9th & 10th grade) students who are interested in preparing to make their Sacrament of Confirmation at St Charles Borromeo parish in Year 3 (11th or 12th grade) will be <u>required</u> to attend a specific number of Life Nights each year to move to the next year of Confirmation prep.
- NOTE: Parents and friends who enjoy cooking and would like to **donate** (<u>no</u> reimbursement) snacks individualized for COVID safety precautions are invited to contact the church parish office or the Director of Youth Ministry.
