We have several digital platforms to keep you updated on progress and allow you the opportunity to help your child achieve grade level standards.

Communication is vital in all areas of our life and especially in our school community. If you ever have any questions while reviewing these platforms, please always reach out to your child's teacher at any time. You may email or call, but Dojo is the quickest way to touch base to have a question answered, or to set up a time for a conference.

If you have any concerns or questions, please always feel free to send me a Dojo message or call the main office to set up a conference.

\*UNIFORM REMINDER -Please remember that open back shoes, crocs, slides, step ins, etc... ARE NOT permitted. These are a hazard during a fire drill or emergency evacuation when children have to move quickly (even on NUD days).

\*The cooler weather has DEFINITELY arrived! Please remember that while we do not go outside in extreme cold, during the cold weather we do have outdoor time both in the morning and at lunch time. Students should be sure to have their coats and sweaters with them so that they are comfortable during recess.
