2017 First Holy Communion Children
Your child is invited to be in the procession at Avista Stadium. First Communicants are to arrive no later than 6 PM at Avista Stadium in First Communion attire. Look for signs saying "First Communicants". They will receive instructions on what to do and have a short rehearsal. Children will be supplied with snack and beverages until the program begins. At 7:10 PM, first communicants will line up with the Bishop. At 7:40 PM they will line both side of the third baseline. At 8:05 PM children will process off the field and seated in a reserved area with their families behind the 3rd base dugout. In addition to First Communicants, children aged 9-14 are invited to be in the procession to carry flowers. Children should wear appropriate "Sunday Best" clothing.
