

Annual Catholic Appeal

Initiative I~1004

Initiative I-1004 is being proposed to be put before the state legislature to institute a "parental notification" law, which would require physicians to notify parents or guardians before performing abortions on minors. The initiative contains reasonable exceptions to protect minors in cases were notification may threaten the safety of a minor or where valid medical exemptions are present. Failure to comply with the law would carry criminal penalties and provide grounds for civil claims. Signature gathering to have this initiative taken to the legislature, to give them the opportunity to approve it, is being done throughout the state. The legislature may then decide to approve or, if not, it would be placed on the ballot for the vote of the people next fall.

The Knights of Columbus will be in the vestibule the weekends of November 16/17 and 23/24 collecting signature on this petition.




