First Friday Adoration April 4th

from 12:00 to 12:30pm & after 7:00pm Stations

Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence during Lent:

- * Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.
- * Everyone 18 or older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- * On Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the regulation does not oblige.
- * Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.


