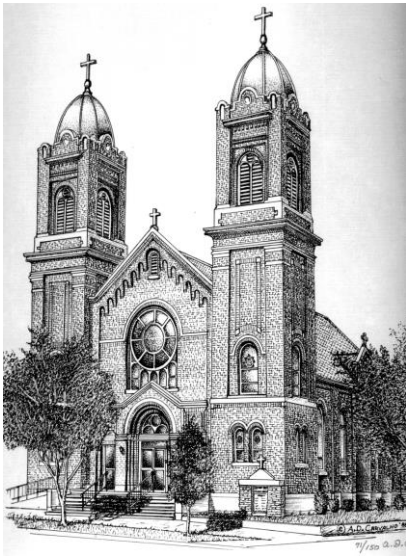

Acts 2.4

Love is the essence of the Christian life. It is both the source of the Christian life and its response, the way in which it must be lived. The feast of Pentecost is the celebration of the beginning of the Christian life, for it was on this day that the Church began. The gift of the Holy Spirit is a wonderful gift, because it transforms us into temples of God's Holy Presence. The Holy Spirit teaches us God's will and enables us to make the proper response to it. Daily prayer is essential to appreciating the presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives. Make today a holy day, a day in which you give thanks to God for the great gift of His love.

Stewarding our Gifts

Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life

The Jewish feast of Pentecost is an ancient one that is associated with the harvesting of grains. It began at Passover and concluded seven weeks later, on Pentecost. On this day, the people would bring “the first fruits” of their labors as an offering in gratitude to God. In the Christian tradition, Pentecost marks the day Christians received a tremendous gift *from* God – the gift of the Holy Spirit. Today’s readings remind us of what this gift means for us. In his letter to the Corinthians, Paul tells us, “To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit.” In the Gospel of John, Jesus says, “As the Father has sent me, so I send you.” It is clear that we have been given much, and we are expected to return the first fruits of our labor to God. It is no coincidence that the Apostles received the gift of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. They were being sent forth, just as we are also being sent forth on a very special kind of harvest. The Spirit that gave the Apostles courage and wisdom for this task does the same for you and I as we go in peace, glorifying the Lord by our lives!

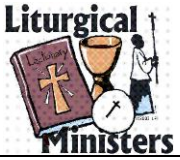

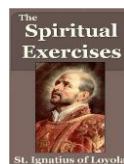

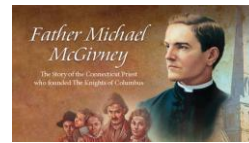

Father Michael McGivney is a documentary that brings to life the story of one of America's most extraordinary Catholic priests. Born in Connecticut of Irish immigrant parents just a few years before the

Civil War, Michael McGivney grew up at a time when millions of Catholic immigrants were struggling to overcome poverty and prejudice. As a parish priest in the gritty New England manufacturing town of New Haven, he made a deep impact on his community, earning the respect of the Protestant establishment and the love of his parishioners at St. Mary's Church. Emboldened to care for families threatened by the death of the breadwinner, Fr. McGivney founded the **Knights of Columbus**, a mutual benefit society that today remains the world's largest Catholic lay organization with 1.8 million members in 13 nations. This film offers a rare glimpse into the life of an extraordinary priest and visionary leader. From defending the persecuted Church to protecting widows and orphans Father Michael McGivney celebrates the triumphs and tribulations of a priest who may very well be America's first canonized parish priest.

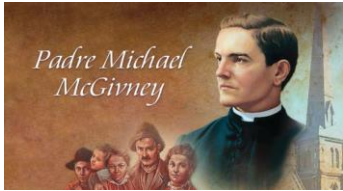

Padre Michael McGivney es un documental que da vida a la historia de uno de los más extraordinarios sacerdotes católicos de Estados Unidos. *Michael*

McGivney que nació en Connecticut de padres inmigrantes irlandeses tan sólo unos años antes de la Guerra Civil, creció en una época en que millones de inmigrantes católicos luchaban para superar la pobreza y los prejuicios. Como párroco en la dura ciudad de *New Haven*, Nueva Inglaterra, provocó un profundo impacto en su comunidad, ganando el respeto de la protestante clase dirigente y el amor de sus feligreses en la parroquia de Santa María.

Con el aliciente de cuidar a las familias amenazadas por la muerte del sostén familiar, el Padre McGivney fundó **Caballeros de Colón**, una sociedad de beneficios mutuos que hoy sigue siendo la organización católica de laicos más grande en el mundo, con 1.8 millones de miembros en 13 países. Esta película ofrece una visión excepcional de la vida de un sacerdote extraordinario y un líder visionario. Desde la defensa de la Iglesia perseguida hasta la protección de viudas y huérfanos, *Padre Michael McGivney* celebra los triunfos y las tribulaciones de un sacerdote que bien podría llegar a ser el primer párroco canonizado de Estados Unidos.
