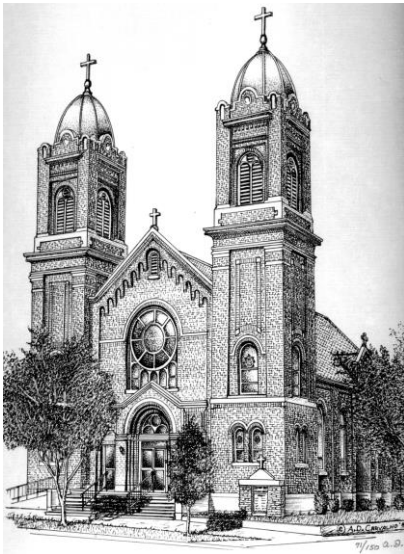

Reflection from the Pastor:

The universalism of the Catholic Church is displayed today in our readings for Pentecost: “Each one heard them speaking in his own language (Acts 2:6)”. The Holy Spirit gathers together in the Church, not just the Jews, but all peoples of the world. Because we are now one with one another in Christ, the concerns of others become our own concerns. We are not *like* brothers and sisters; rather we *are* brothers and sisters in Christ, for we have one



Father. So, in a particular way, Bishop Kemme and I invite you to pray for the people of the Republic of Ireland. They have an important decision to make on May 25: whether to allow abortion in their country or

not. As of now, unborn children are constitutionally protected, but many outside forces are sending in money and other support to deceive the Irish people into thinking that abortion is a “human right”. Between now and then, I implore you to fast and pray that this measure will be defeated. All, from youngest to oldest, have a right to life.

Meditación del Párroco:

El universalismo de la Iglesia Católica se muestra hoy en las lecturas de Pentecostés: "Cada uno los oía hablar en su propio idioma (Hechos 2:6)". El Espíritu Santo se reúne en la Iglesia, no solo los judíos, sino todos los pueblos del mundo. Debido a que ahora somos uno con los otros en Cristo, las preocupaciones de los demás se convierten en nuestras propias preocupaciones. No somos *como* hermanos y hermanas; más bien, *somos* hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, porque tenemos un solo Padre. Entonces, de una manera particular, el Señor Obispo y yo te invitamos a orar por la gente de la República de Irlanda. Los cuidanos de la República de Irlanda tienen una decisión importante que tomar el 25 de mayo: si permitir el aborto en su país o no. A partir de ahora, los niños no nacidos están constitucionalmente protegidos, pero muchas fuerzas extranjeras están enviando dinero y otro apoyo para engañar a los irlandeses y hacerles creer que el aborto es un "derecho humano". Entre ahora y entonces, te imploro ayunar y rezar para que esta medida sea derrotada. Todos, desde los más jóvenes hasta los más viejos, tienen derecho a la vida.
