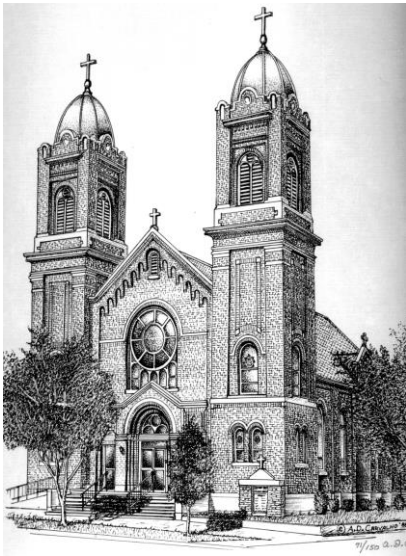

Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time –September 9, 2018



Reflection from the Pastor:

Today's Second Reading from the Epistle of St. James describes an all too human defect: preferring the successful to those who are materially poor. Ancient cultures as well as modern day ones often conflate one's economic success to someone's intrinsic value and dignity. But since Our Lord Jesus Christ, a new perspective has come into the world: we are all created by the God who loves us all. That value has changed Western culture and the basis for society. The Declaration of Independence, written by Thomas Jefferson, says that "all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness". Jefferson was able to assert the equality of all because he understood that before God, we are created equal. Obviously, there are differences in ability and means, but fundamentally we are all equal. When Christians help the poor, we do so because we love our brothers and sisters who are also created in God's image and likeness. Meditación del Párroco:

La Segunda Lectura de hoy de la Epístola de Santiago describe un defecto demasiado humano: preferir el éxito a los que son materialmente pobres. Las culturas antiguas, así como las modernas, a menudo confunden el éxito económico con el valor y la dignidad intrínseca de alguien. Pero desde Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, una nueva perspectiva ha venido al mundo: todos somos creados por el Dios que nos ama a todos. Ese valor ha cambiado la cultura occidental y la base de la sociedad. La Declaración de Independencia, escrita por Thomas Jefferson, dice que "todos los hombres son creados iguales, que están dotados por su Creador de ciertos derechos inalienables, que entre ellos están la vida, la libertad y la búsqueda de la felicidad". Jefferson pudo afirmar la igualdad de todos porque entendió que, ante Dios, somos creados iguales. Obviamente, hay diferencias en habilidad y medios, pero fundamentalmente todos somos iguales. Cuando los cristianos ayudan a los pobres, lo hacemos porque amamos a nuestros hermanos y hermanas que también han sido creados a imagen y semejanza de Dios.
