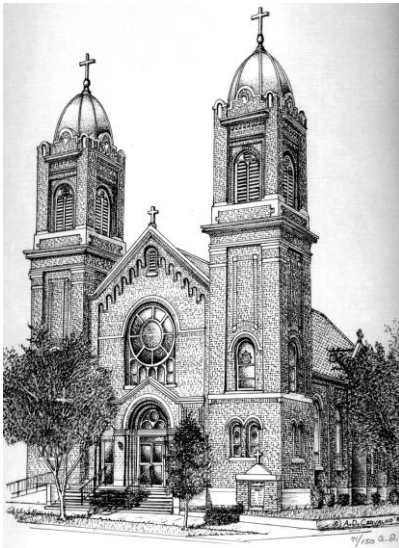

From the Stewardship Office:

Frequently Asked Questions about Stewardship Renewal

Stewardship is the grateful response of a Christian disciple who recognizes and receives God's gifts and shares these gifts in love of God and neighbor.

Stewardship can be misinterpreted as a gimmick, an attempt to get us to write a bigger check to the church or volunteer more time. Realistically, stewardship is the loving response of God's love for us by living the individual and universal call to discipleship, a lifelong "way of life," whereby one responds to the mission and ministry of the local and universal church, sharing the Gospel of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Stewardship enables Christians to gauge the extent of their faith and love of Jesus by the stewardship they perform.

We are all at different stages of our understanding of stewardship and our willingness to accept stewardship in our daily lives. But one thing is clear, each of us can grow closer in our relationship with God by consciously, prayerfully determining what our next stewardship action will be. God gives us time, talent, and treasure to bring us closer to the living Christ; to enter into deeper communion with Him by extending His mercy to others. By extending His love, we become more and more the person God created us to be.

Preguntas frecuentes sobre la renovación de la corresponsabilidad

La corresponsabilidad es la respuesta agradecida de un discípulo cristiano que reconoce y recibe los dones de Dios y comparte estos dones en amor a Dios y al prójimo.

La mayordomía puede malinterpretarse como un truco, un intento de hacernos escribir un cheque más grande a la iglesia o ser voluntarios por más tiempo. Siendo realistas, la corresponsabilidad es la respuesta amorosa del amor de Dios por nosotros al vivir el llamado individual y universal al discipulado, un "camino de vida" de por vida, mediante el cual uno responde a la misión y ministerio de la iglesia local y universal, compartiendo el Evangelio del vida, muerte y resurrección de Jesucristo. La mayordomía permite a los cristianos medir el alcance de su fe y el amor de Jesús por la mayordomía que realizan.

Todos estamos en diferentes etapas de nuestra comprensión de la mayordomía y nuestra voluntad de aceptar la mayordomía en nuestra vida diaria. Pero una cosa está clara, cada uno de nosotros puede acercarse más en nuestra relación con Dios al determinar conscientemente y en oración cuál será nuestra próxima acción de mayordomía. Dios nos da tiempo, talento y tesoro para acercarnos al Cristo vivo; entrar en una comunión más profunda con Él extendiendo Su misericordia a los demás. Al extender Su amor, nos convertimos cada vez más en la persona que Dios nos creó para ser.

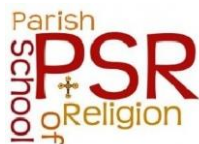
