### Saint Spotlight – July 11

This Friday is the feast of Saint Benedict, the Father of Latin Monasticism. His life is a representation of “communion” in the contrast to “division.” In the time there were pagan armies on the march, schism within the church, and immorality was prevalent tearing communities apart. He sought to leave it all, wash his hands of society, and chose to be a hermit so that he could be alone with God. He seemed happier, but something still stirred within him. Eventually he would gather around himself a family of monks into a “Grand Monastery.” By doing so he established a model for all religious orders to follow. By the grace of God, he built a communion of persons centered on God by prayer, study, work, and charity. As we celebrate his feast day let us remember that true communion cannot be built on policies, philosophies, or goals. True communion can only be built on the Word of God.



### Santo destacado – 11 de julio

Este viernes se celebra la festividad de San Benito, el Padre del Monacato Latino. Su vida representa la "comunidad" en contraste con la "división". En aquella época, había ejércitos paganos en marcha, cismas dentro de la Iglesia y la inmoralidad prevalecía, desgarrando comunidades. Buscó dejarlo todo, desentenderse de la sociedad y eligió ser ermitaño para estar a solas con Dios. Parecía más feliz, pero algo aún se agitaba en su interior. Con el tiempo, reuniría a su alrededor a una familia de monjes en un «Gran Monasterio». Con ello, estableció un modelo a seguir para todas las órdenes religiosas. Por la gracia de Dios, construyó una comunidad de personas centradas en Dios mediante la oración, el estudio, el trabajo y la caridad. Al celebrar su festividad, recordemos que la verdadera comunión no se basa en políticas, filosofías ni objetivos. La verdadera comunión solo se basa en la Palabra de Dios.
