

The cemetery authorities shall remove all. Plants, flowers and wreaths are permitted on plots at the head of the grave in acceptable temporary containers, but will be removed when unsightly or within reasonable discretion of Cemetery Authorities.

The impact on our family can be devastating. Just like a profound loss. We may be grieving.

Two most surefire spin-offs of grief are anger and broken relationships. It is a factor in relocation, death, divorce and other major losses. It is suggested that one can assume and never be wrong: If you have experienced grief, there is someone you need to forgive. And of course, there is the possibility that someone needs to forgive you. But that is their task. Hold Jesus in your heart and hear Him forgive those who nailed Him to the cross. For us we may need to do this every day until we succeed in sustained and accomplished forgiveness.

On June 1st, all instruction will be completed, and your students should have all assignments submitted.

From June 1-June 3, teachers will prepare report cards.

On June 2nd, we will be scheduling drop off/pickup procedures. Students should plan to return Chromebooks, textbooks, or any other school materials in their possession.

On June 2nd, students will pick up any materials or personal items that are still at school.

We will follow a schedule managed alphabetically, by last name, so that families can exchange all materials at the same time. For example, Students with the last name beginning with the letter A-H will be scheduled to make the exchange between 9:00 and 10:00 am. Students with the last name beginning with the letters I-P will be scheduled to make the exchange between 10:00 and 11:00 am. Students with the last name beginning with the letters Q-Z will be scheduled to make the exchange between 10:00 and 11:00 am.

Students who wish to Chalk the Walk - the front sidewalk, or the parking lot - will be invited to do so while they wait to complete the exchange or before they leave.

Everyone should plan to wear a mask while in any proximity to teachers or fellow students.

Everyone should observe the social distancing guidelines during this process.

We will also plan a tailgate/car procession for June 5th. PK will drive through between 9:00 and 9:30 am. K will proceed from 9:30 - 10:00. 8th grade will proceed from 10:15 pm. - 11:00 am.

All other families will be asked to line the street with signs to honk and wave as the groups go by.
