

GREEN PHASE

Mindful that previous Orders from the Governor exempt Religious Houses of Worship, the Diocese of Allentown will continue to follow the current diocesan guidelines (Green Phase, Part I). Green Phase - Part I Churches will be permitted "no more than 50% of their occupancy." Most Blessed Sacrament Church maximum capacity currently is 140.

Mass attendance remains voluntary in the green phase. Those who do not feel safe, or who have compromising health conditions, should not attend. The dispensation from the Mass obligation will remain in place.

The main priority is the safety of the faithful, and the safety of priests. The faithful will be required to wear masks. Strict social distancing will be required, and ushers will help ensure that protocol.

The Church will be open weekdays from 9 AM until 7 PM for private prayer and private Adoration.

All public devotions such as: Benediction, Solemn Adoration on Tuesday, Family Rosary on Thursdays, etc. are not permitted.

There will be no hymnals, to help prevent the spread of the virus. Only certain entrances and exits will be in use, and the faithful will be dismissed by pew to limit large gatherings after Mass.

Holy Water fonts will remain empty.

All Parish activities are canceled until further notice.

All Parish facilities are closed, and all events are canceled or postponed.

We want to recover from our grief quickly. We hope to grow through our loss. BUT because grief recovery is so demanding we will look for any way to get out of going through it. None of us wants to feel the loneliness and heartache it brings. We tend to try to avoid it. We try to get over it quickly. And, when this does not work and it never does, we try to wait it out in hope that "Time Heals All Wounds." This is another expression of Denial and Withdrawal. It is not true. It is like saying 'Practice Makes Perfect.' Only perfect practice makes perfect!

Only effectively working through grief heals the deep wounds and creates balance in our lives once more. Effective grief work is not done alone. That is where regularly attending a grief support group is every valuable. It helps one to stay connected and to know we are not going crazy.
