



My Dear Parishioners,

It is my great joy to share with you the news of me being assigned to join your parish community! I am truly happy to soon live among you and to share my faith and the gift of my priesthood with you. But before that, I want to shortly describe some facts about my life so that you may know something more about me. I was born on March 10, 1988, in the small town of Krasnystaw in the Southeast part of Poland as the second child of Joseph and Anna Kiszka. I also have a one-year older brother, Greg. From an early age, I lived in an apartment building in the village of Wierzba - also located in Southeast part of Poland. I attended my elementary and middle schools there. In high school, I commuted daily to the nearby city of Zamość.

After finishing high school, I decided to be a priest in the Archdiocese of Warsaw. To do so, I moved in 2007 from my hometown to the capital where I entered the Archdiocesan Seminary. Here I gained the necessary academic, theological, and life skills. After five years of study, I had a wonderful parish practicum in the suburban parish of Słomczyn.

After that year, I decided to leave for a year to discern my vocation living in the world. At this time, I rented an apartment in Warsaw and worked in a secular position. This year helped to me to decide to return to complete my studies and to graduate from the seminary.

After graduation, I started at St. Anna Parish in Piaseczno, but the call to be a missionary was on my heart. At that time, two of my friends came back from Chicago and told me that the United States was in need of priests. I applied and was accepted to come to the US in 2016. At first, I lived at the Bartimaeus House of discernment in Boonton with a weekend assignment at St. Rose of Lima Parish in East Hanover.

In 2017, upon being ordained as a deacon for the Diocese of Paterson, I was sent to Our Lady of Mercy Parish in Whippany, where I lived until June 2018. After my ordination as a priest, Bishop Serratelli assigned me to St. Patrick Church in Chatham, where I worked one year. In 2019, I moved to Our Lady of the Lake Church in Sparta. I am a big fan of soccer. In my free time, I either read or watch religious videos or podcasts - and especially homilies and sermons of other priests and pastors.

I just wanted to say how happy I am to soon join your parish community and to grow in faith and spirit with you. Together, we can deepen our relationship with God and help each other to be closer to Him each and every day of our lives. I wish you all the best and I will see you at the beginning of November! May God bless you all!




Join us this fall for a group discussion series of *The Chosen*, led by parishioner Kelly Falcone.


