

Jesus chose to go there because he wanted to confront himself. This desert allowed him to look and ask the deepest questions about his purpose on this earth without being distracted.



allow ourselves to be changed by God, to change our course. During Lent, we make this same journey with Jesus into the desert -- to look at ourselves and honestly see how we are living, who we are living for, and where God fits into our lives. We are all tempted to keep doing what we do for the rest of the year and avoid these questions.

When we use all that the Church provides for us during this season, we journey with Jesus into the desert to make great progress. Extra prayer, giving to the poor, using Confession, reading the Bible more, trying to reestablish relationships that are broken, and fasting. All these practices help us together to move out of our routines. We allow God to move back to the center of our lives, and to put all other relationships/things in their proper place again. We turn from sin and learn how to love more deeply and authentically like Christ.

Making this journey is not easy. It requires self-denial, patience, and trust, knowing that we are not in control of the process. This is why we make this journey together. We support and challenge one another knowing that God will reward our efforts. For every step that we take towards God and others, God takes two. Jesus invites each of us to personally journey with him and one another for these 40 days! We make this journey in response to such a great love that we have received from God.

Don't miss out on this opportunity. Where it leads us is worth the effort!

GUIDELINES DURING LENT



Roman Catholics are asked to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and on all Fridays during Lent. The rule is for Catholics aged 14 and above, unless there are mitigating heath concerns. In this case, one can do a good work in place of this.

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, we are also asked to fast (those 18 to 59). Fasting means a person is permitted to eat one full meal during the day. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but they are not to equal that of a full meal. For those with mitigating health issues who are unable to fast and/or abstain, one can do a good work in place of this.

While those are the only two days of full fasting and abstinence required, all of Lent should be a time of spiritual formation and preparation for Easter. Also recommended are spiritual activities, such as spending more times studying the Scriptures, attending Mass more frequently, as well as the traditional Lenten Devotions (Stations of the Cross, Bible studies, Lenten talks, and the Rosary), and other acts of sacrifice such as reaching out to those in need around us. 

QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTIONS

If you've been a good saver and you want to share your love with Corpus Christi, you can gift directly from your IRA. These gifts, called Qualified Charitable Distribtions (QCD's), can be made when the IRA owner reaches age 70 1/2. Note that if a donor wishes to make a QCD from their IRA, they cannot do so until the day they actually turn age 70 1/2. QCD's can be done only from IRA accounts, whether traditional or Roth, and even inherited IRAs are included.
