The brick pillars are completed, the sign is ready for installation and a Christmas Tree will be planted behind this, as well as several bushes. In the early spring, the grass will be put down, in addition to other shrubs and a rock border. A sprinkler system will be installed to ensure that the plants flourish.

These repairs are a testament to our shared commitment to preserving and growing the place where we come together in faith. Thanks to your generous support, we will be able to make these much-needed repairs and upgrades a reality to our spiritual home. Corpus Christi has been an important part of our community for almost 60 years. We are currently planning for the next 60 years!





PIONEER IN FOOTBALL AND PILLAR OF FAITH

Shortly after entering the NFL in 1962, Leroy Jackson was traded to the Washington Redskins. The trade was controversial as the Redskins were the only NFL team that hadn't yet integrated black players.

Nowadays, Jackson, a member of the Knights of Columbus, is a security guard at the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC. He gets into the shrine every morning at 5:00 to get it ready for visitors, and then prays the rosary.

The Grand Knight of his council was shocked to learn this humble Knight was THE Leroy Jackson, a pioneer for blacks in the NFL. Monsignor Rossi, the shrine's Rector, describes the Knights as men of faith and action, and that Jackson has exemplified that throughout his life. Jackson has told him that being a Knight has deepened his faith.

The role of the Corpus Christi Parish Pastoral Council:

Ideal Candidates:

- Embody the Parish Vision (Christ's Joy, Hope, and Healing Received and Shared) and Parish Mission through service to the parish community.
- Have a personal commitment to an active prayer/faith life.
- · Are willing to contribute individual talents/skills and treasure to the best of his/her ability.

Requirements to be a candidate for the September 2025 - May 2028 term:

- · Have been a registered member of the Parish for at least 6 months.
- Have received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation*
- Are willing to serve a 3-year term, and are available to attend Council meetings (held on Saturday mornings, five (5) sessions per year,
 September through June)
- · Participate in some aspects of Parish Life.

*or are a teen preparing for confirmation; teens may choose to serve a 2-year term.
