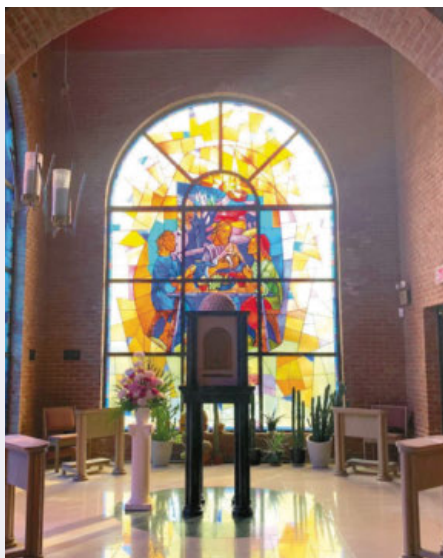

A Deeper Look with Fr. Kevin

PRAYER AS A FAMILY

"The Family that prays together, stays together!" This phrase was made famous by Fr. Patrick Peyton, who repeated this everywhere he went. Prayer had been ingrained in him early, as each night his father would kneel and lead the family in the rosary. Fr. Peyton was so successful in spreading this message that in 2001, his cause for canonization was opened.

Fr. Peyton realized that prayer is the life-breath of the spiritual life for each of us. It makes sense that it would be the life-breath of family life too. Parents demonstrate to their children how to walk, talk, and take care of themselves. In the same way, for something so important as faith to take root, it must be witnessed to children repeatedly by their parents.

Prayer is all about intimacy with our God and one another. Prayer strengthens lasting family bonds better than any other activities. It helps them to learn and affirm forgiveness, mercy, and cooperation. It teaches them to tune their 'spiritual ears' to come to know when God speaks. They receive grace to help them in ways that others don't. Through prayer, your family can learn to focus outwards and develop a deeper love for all people. Why wouldn't we want to share this with our children?

There are many reasons why families don't pray together. Maybe they never learned to do this when they grew up. Maybe they are afraid of their children's reaction. Maybe they think that prayer is the church's responsibility.

Yet when you pray with your family, *you* demonstrate to them that it is a priority in your life. Children need to know that *you* need God, that you don't have to be in control of every situation and that *you* know that there is a source of hope for any situation. Actions speak louder than words.

If you feel awkward about starting to pray as a family, know that you are not alone. Start simply and early. Gather as a family and pray before each meal, thanking God for the food and all the blessings in your life. As you progress, try having a prayer card that you can take turns saying. You can invite each member of your family to add an intention or something that they are thankful for. This can expand to other times: to conversations in the car, and in difficulties where you can teach them to trust in God. Even if your children are older, start to pray with them. Teach them that prayer doesn't have to be long or formal. Let it be brief, honest, and respectful. There are many resources on the internet to help!

Emphasize that praying together is about growing in relationship with the God who loves them, more than just asking for something. It is about teaching them to become comfortable inviting God into all the parts of their lives.

While Mass is the most important way we pray each week, praying as a family can powerfully benefit them their whole lives, in ways that other activities and sports cannot. **It is easy to understand why - families that pray together, stay together!** Corpus Christi can help. Reach out to a staff member or ask a priest for an idea; invite your extended family to Mass for a special celebration; begin the holidays with Mass, try a new program this Lent to deepen your faith. CONGRATULATIONS Fr. Kevin!

Bishop Sweeney recently appointed Fr. Kevin, pastor of Corpus Christi Parish, as the **Diocese of Paterson's Minister to Priests**. The position of Minister to Priests is an essential resource of the presbyterate. The Minister to Priests maintains a relationship of privileged confidence with the priests of the diocese, providing outreach and support for priests in crisis, personal transition, or in need of help. Additionally, reflecting the bishop's pastoral concern for the presbyterate, the Minister to Priests conveys the thoughts, feelings, and needs of the priests of the diocese.

SOME THOUGHTS ON CAVEMEN AND GOD'S WILL FOR YOUR LIFE. -BY JIM MURRAY

In his book "Living Joy" Catholic author and speaker Chris Stefanick writes about 9 steps to having a more joy-filled life. And the first step, may be the most powerful step to unleashing a torrent of Joy, is so simple that it runs the risk of being obvious. When you hear it, you might be tempted to respond with something like: "Well duh, I could have thought of that." It's something that we are all capable of at any moment of any day in any circumstance. It is, as St. Paul writes in his letter to the Thessalonians, God's will for us. It's simple. It's Gratitude.

"In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus." (1 Thessalonians 5:18) When I hear it I can't help thinking of that Geico commercial: "Gratitude: It's so easy..." Yet how often are we truly grateful for the people, things, and circumstances that God has blessed us with? Far too often, we allow the possessions and blessings of others to steal our Joy. Instead of being grateful for what we do have, we fixate on what others have. In "Living Joy" Chris encourages us to practice intentional gratitude each day, by starting the morning with "counting your gratefuls." He (and the apostle Paul) challenge us to turn even our triggers into opportunities for gratitude. So if you get cut off in traffic, respond with gratitude-"Lord, thank you that I have a car that works!" If you get a bad grade in school-"God, thank you that I have the opportunity to receive a good education, and teachers that challenge me!" The more we learn to give thanks in all things, the more Joy we will have, and isn't that what we all really want? I know it's what God wants for us. So let's start practicing gratitude. It's so easy a caveman can do it.

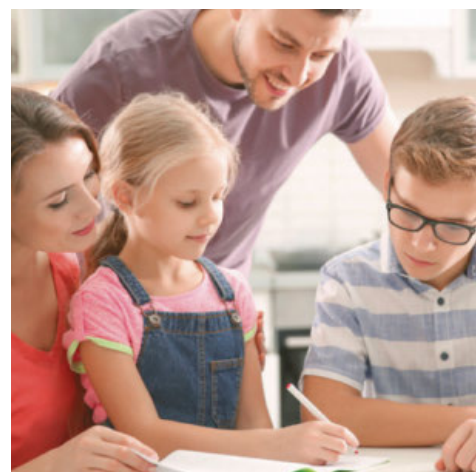

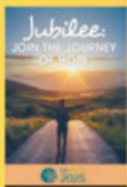

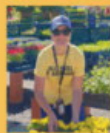
