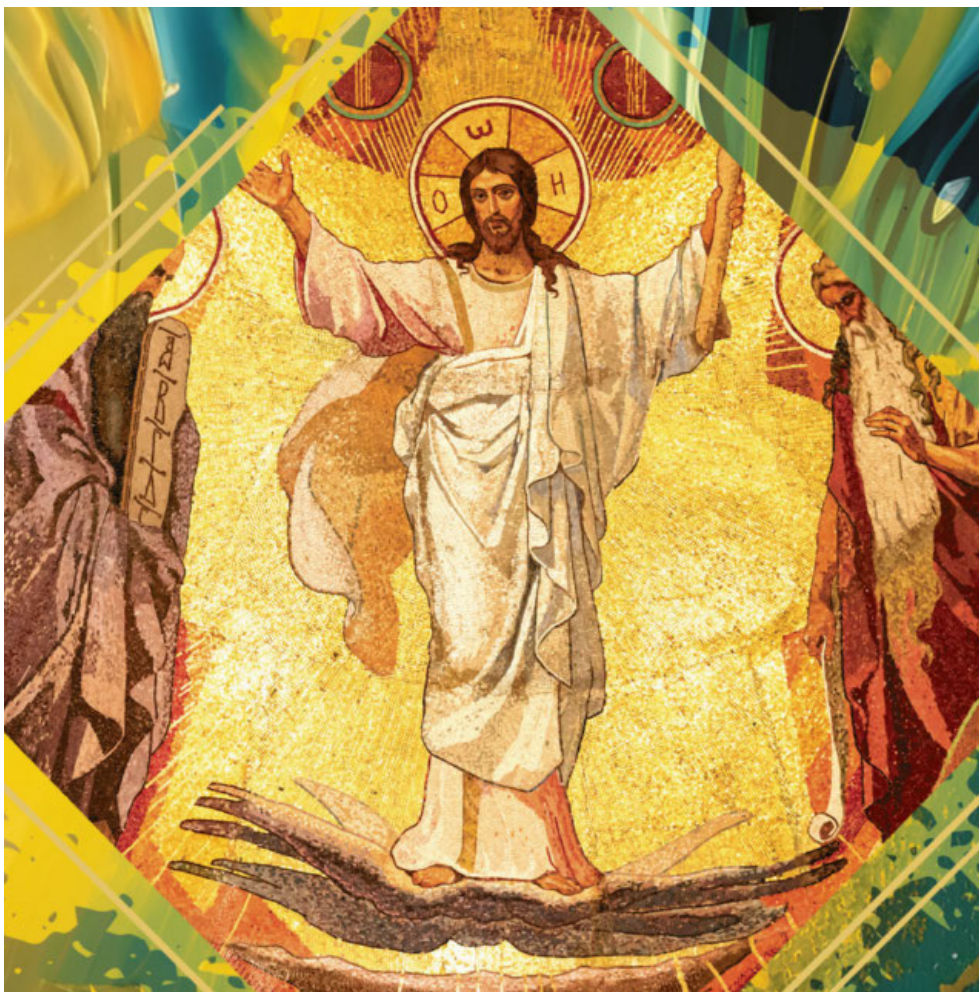

A Deeper Look with Fr. Kevin

In the Path of Transformations

The Italian violin maker, Stradivarius, made the most prized violins ever made because of the rich and resonating sound they produce. The unique sound of a Stradivarius cannot be duplicated. These precious instruments were not made from treasured pieces of wood; they were carved from discarded lumber. Stradivarius was very poor and could not afford fine materials like his contemporaries. So, he got most of his wood from the dirty harbors where he lived. He would take those waterlogged pieces of wood to his shop and clean them up, dry them out, and from those trashed pieces of lumber he would create instruments of rare beauty.

It has since been discovered that while that wood floated in those dirty harbors, microbes went into the wood and ate out the center of those cells. This left just a fibrous infrastructure of the wood that created resonating chambers for the music. From wood that nobody wanted, Stradivarius produced violins that now everybody wants.

The violins of Stradivarius can teach us something about Christian transformation. God can change us instantly as Jesus does in today's gospel event of the Transfiguration. The dazzling display of light, that Peter, James, and John witness surrounding Jesus, is a preview of what we will one day experience. Yet most of the time, this transformation takes time. During Lent, we intentionally allow God to change us inside and out. How? By the Eucharist! Each week, the Eucharist deepens our relationship with God more than anything else can. Going to confession is the powerful means that God offers us to find healing and to remove those "burdens" that we carry all year, freeing us to love others and God more deeply. As we journey with Jesus through the desert, we focus more on prayer, fasting, almsgiving, forgiveness and charity. And we take advantage of the many opportunities to encounter Christ and serve others. Although this is not always easy, we are reminded that, in times of doubt and uncertainty, the expectation of our future transformation helps us to turn to God and to take to heart his consoling words to us: *"This is my beloved Son in whom I am well pleased."*

A CELEBRATION OF CATHOLIC PATRIOTISM

Amid much fanfare, Knights of Columbus and family members from across the United States and beyond assembled in St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City on February 22 to mark the 125th anniversary of the Fourth Degree: Patriotism. It is one of the principles of the Knights of Columbus, along with Charity, Unity and Fraternity.

Cardinal Timothy Dolan, archbishop of New York, welcomed the Knights to the cathedral, fittingly known as "America's Parish Church." 650 men, including 20 West Point cadets, became Fourth Degree Knights, witnessed by Archbishop Lori of Baltimore and 20 priests.

Cardinal Dolan noted that Father McGivney, the founder of the K of C "responded [to anti-Catholic prejudice] as he formed his Knights of Columbus for God and country, teaching them that loyal citizenship as Americans and fidelity to the one holy Catholic faith were not at odds, but intimately allied."

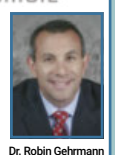
