A Deeper Look with Fr. Kevin

The Prodigal Father

This weekend Jesus tells us the story about what many people call the Prodigal Son. Yet it seems to be better titled, "The Prodigal Father." A father loves his two sons with an <u>over-the-top</u> kind of love. How did they respond? <u>The First son</u>: responded by wanting his inheritance before his father had died. He didn't care about his father or his family's future. He was searching for joy but looked in the wrong places. Looking to fill the emptiness within him, he ended up with more emptiness than he had ever experienced before. He "hired himself out to one of the local citizens who sent him to his farm to tend the swine. And he longed to eat his fill of the pods on which the swine fed, but nobody gave him any." For a Jew in Jesus time, there was nothing lower than eating the food of pigs. <u>The Second Son</u>: appeared to be the perfect son, but his heart was far from his father. He did everything that he was told, but he only seemed to care about himself. He was full of jealousy and hatred. He would not love or forgive his brother.

The father responds to the first: Every day he spent his time looking in the distance waiting for his son's return. Nothing else mattered! When he saw the son, he didn't wait for him, he ran to him. He didn't care about his reputation. He didn't give his son time to speak, wrapping his arms around him and kissing him. He didn't want to hear his son asking for forgiveness but calls for the fattened calf to be slaughtered. At the end, he calls for a great party for his long-lost son.

<u>The father responds to the second</u>: He searches until he finds him. He listens to his son's half-hearted excuses about why he didn't want to forgive his brother. The father knew the son preferred justice over mercy, yet the father loved him anyway. He invites him to take his proper place at the feast.

Prodigal – "giving something on a lavish scale." Who loves like this father– no one! Jesus is implying that this is how he loves us. Loving in an over-the-top way to those who don't earn or deserve this kind of love. This is how God treats us!

At times, we are like both sons in the story. Lent is about being honest before our loving Father as to which son we have been. God loves us anyway! He asks us to receive His forgiveness and to become like the father- and share the father's kind of love.




