A Deeper Look with Fr. Kevin

Emptying to be Filled

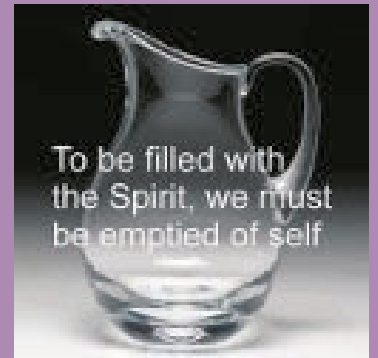
John Newton was the captain of a slave trade ship. One night in 1748, his ship was caught in a vicious storm. Waves crashed over the bow and the ship was tossed about like a toy. He had been reading the Bible and had a profound conversion experience, where he saw his life clearly and the errors of his ways. Newton saw the hand of God getting him and his crew through the storm. He would later pen the hymn, Amazing Grace. *"Amazing grace/ How sweet the sound / That saved a wretch like me / I once was lost, but now I'm found/ Was blind, but now I see."*

As a disciple in relationship with Jesus, John Newton was willing to leave behind his lucrative slave trade. His relationship with God eventually led him to devote his life to actively lobbying against slavery. As we come close to the end of Lent, Jesus speaks tenderly to each of us. Jesus loves us too much to have just a casual relationship with us. Jesus wants a relationship with us built on mutual commitment and sacrifice. Lent is a good time to ask ourselves, "What are we willing to sacrifice for this relationship?"

During Lent, we are called to let go of those things in our hearts that don't belong there. Maybe it is pride, anger, selfishness, jealousy, materialism, power, position, or unforgiveness. During Lent, we let Jesus help us by taking away our sins in confession. There is confession at our parish and in all the Catholic parishes in Morris County on Mondays during Lent from 7:00pm to 8:30pm. Don't be afraid!

Being emptied of these things that take up space in our hearts is only the first step. Lent is then about allowing Jesus to fill our hearts. Our hearts were made for this. In doing so, we remember who we are and to Whom we belong!



CONNECTING THE VATICAN TO THE WORLD

The Knights of Columbus donated a state-of-the-art mobile broadcasting unit to the Vatican, unveiling the new vehicle in time for the Jubilee Year 2025. It's the fourth broadcasting unit donated to the Vatican by the K of C, supporting the Vatican's communication office for decades.

The unit will be used to deliver the message of Jesus Christ from the Vatican to Catholics and people of goodwill around the world.

During a private audience with Pope Francis, Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly shared updates on the Knights' worldwide charitable outreach and other initiatives. He said, "The Knights of Columbus, since our founding, has always enjoyed a very strong union with the Holy Father. That is just part of who the Knights of Columbus is, to be in unity with Rome and in unity with the Church."

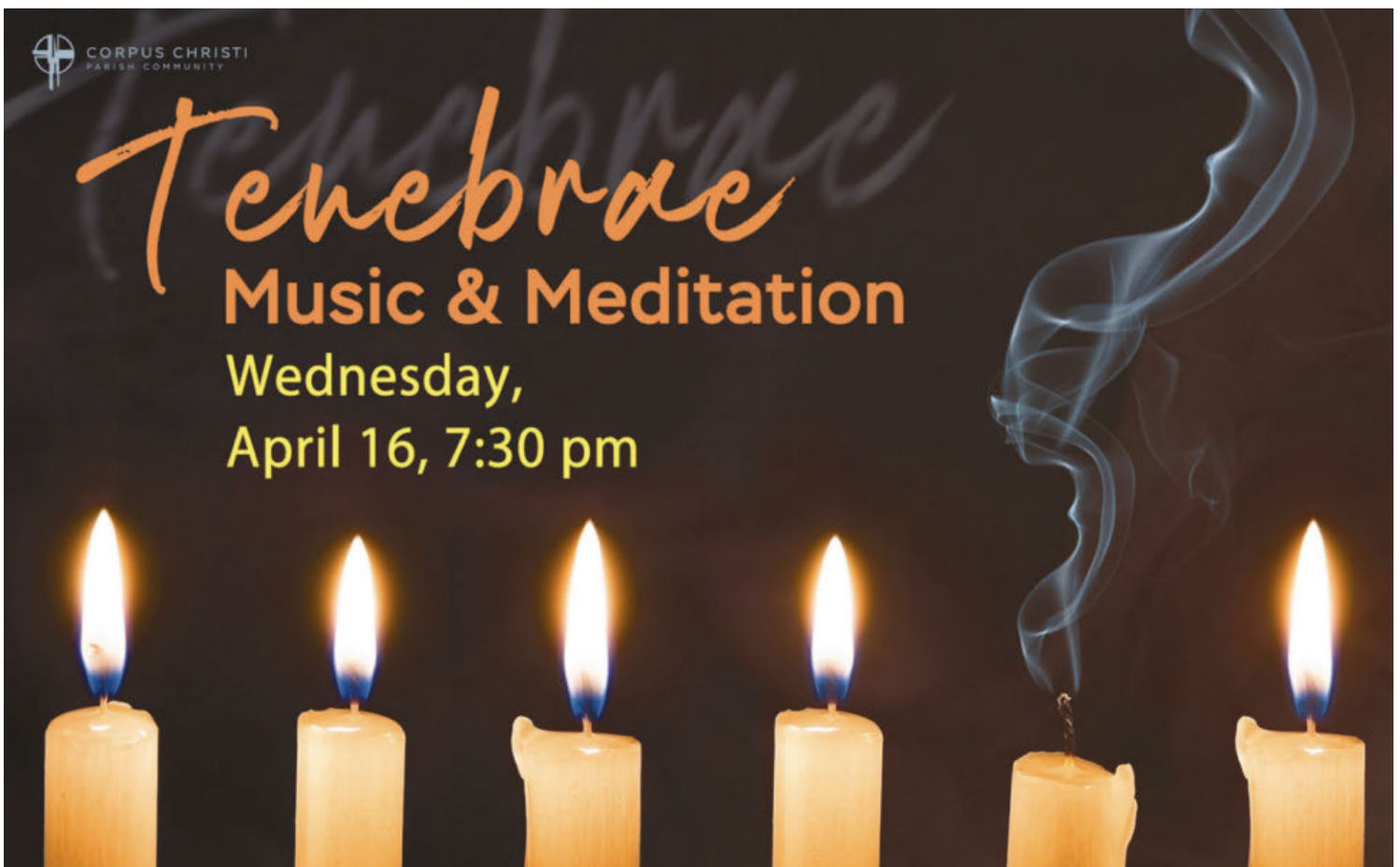
