A Deeper Look with Fr. Kevin

Palm Sunday and the Beginning of Holy Week

This weekend we receive the palms at the beginning of Mass. They are blessed and then the priest enters the church to begin the procession. This reminds us of Jesus, at the end of his ministry, entering Jerusalem and the beginning of his journey towards his Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

It is easy for us to lose the impact of what happened 2000 years ago. Yet, if we look closely at the Passion story, it is not to highlight the cruelty of the Romans and the leadership of the Temple. It is rather to recall why Jesus chose to go through this ordeal, not only freely, but with a sense of fulfillment. How often there is injustice in our world, and how seldom others risk their own comfort to change things for the better, to right a wrong, to challenge the establishment, to bring peace. Not so with Jesus! Out of love for each one of us, Jesus walked this path of unimaginable suffering. It is hard to fathom such total self-giving for others, for us!

During this time, we are called to reflect on how committed God has been to us. If we were the only person who ever lived, Jesus would have gladly gone through this ordeal for us alone! We are asked now, during Holy Week, to journey with Jesus in our own lives. To let our toughened hearts be touched again by such a great love. We follow Jesus into the uncertainty of our own lives and our world, trusting that Jesus will see us through to the other side, where all will be well!

Please consider journeying with Corpus Christi this week with all the Holy Week events especially on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. This information is found on our website (corpuschristi.org) and on page 5. A journey worth making!

OUR LADY'S CARPENTER

On Dec. 8, 2024, the world was riveted on Notre-Dame de Paris, restored to its full splendor after five years of painstaking labor. Jean-Baptiste Bonhoure, a member of the K of C council in Béhuard, France, was present in his capacity as president of the company that rebuilt the nave, choir, and north and south belfries of the 850-year-old cathedral.

But it was the Mass attended a week later by the 1,500 craftsmen who had worked on the project, including 50 skilled carpenters and joiners from his company, that moved Bonhoure deeply.

When he's not busy restoring historic buildings or taking care of his family of eight, Bonhoure participates in his council's charitable activities, including serving homeless people in their community and visiting prisoners to bring them a glimmer of hope.

Palm Sunday

How quickly things can change. For Palm Sunday, we begin with triumphal music singing "Hosanna to the Son of David" and "All glory, laud, and honor to you, redeemer, king" to mark Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. In what feels like only moments later, we sing Psalm 22 – "my God, my God, why have you abandoned me?"

During Lent, we take time to be a little bit more deliberate and mindful with our actions and choices. As we sing *Again We Keep This Solemn Fast*, we pray the following text.

More sparing, therefore, let us make
The words we speak, the food we take,
Our sleep, our laughter, ev'ry sense;
Learn peace through holy penitence.

Tenebrae

Tenebrae means darkness or shadows. Using scripture readings and musical reflections we are invited to follow the story of Holy Week and to accompany Jesus in his last hours. Throughout the experience, candles are extinguished until the church is filled with darkness. This gradual darkness symbolizes Jesus' increasing sorrow as the events of Passion Week progress.

Please consider attending this experience of music and meditation on Wednesday, April 16 at 7:30pm. Musical reflections will be sung by the Corpus Christi Choir and friends.

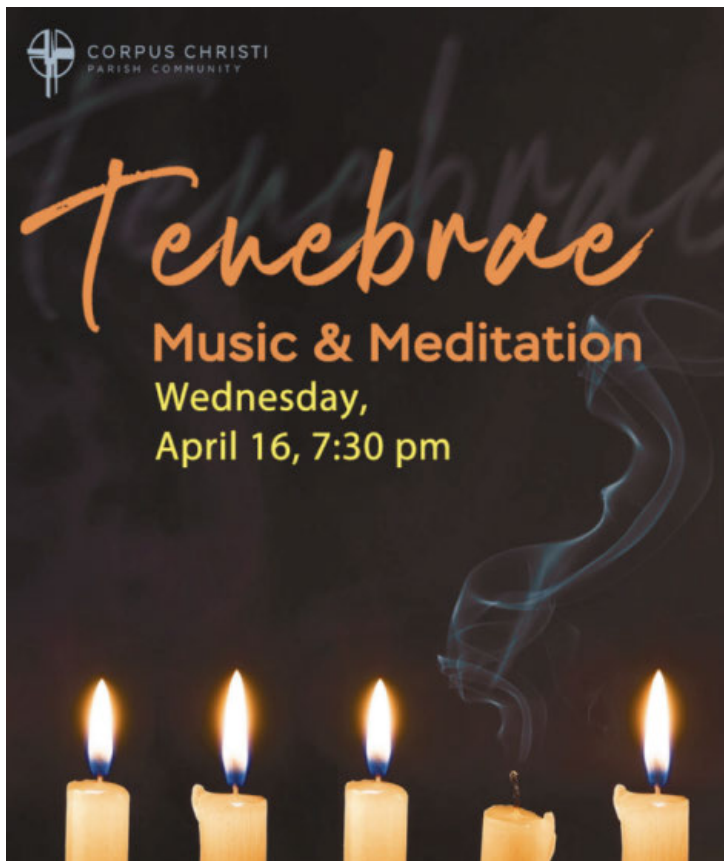
