Ordination to the Priesthood

The Most Reverend Kevin Sweeney has happily announced that he intends to ordain the Rev. Mr. Joseph S. DeMarzo III, of our parish, to the Sacred Order of Presbyter on Saturday, June 7th, 2025, at the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist in Paterson, New Jersey. The faithful of the Diocese of Paterson and our parish are asked to pray for him and for the other young men who are being called by God to service in the Church. At the same time, according to the custom of the Church, the faithful are obliged to reveal any known impediments to sacred orders by contacting Fr. Kevin or Bishop Sweeney before the ordination in accord with the norms of #1045 and 1051.2 of the Code of Canon Law. May John the Baptist, patron saint of the Diocese of Paterson, intercede for these men and for an increase in vocations to the priesthood here in northern New Jersey.


