

A Deeper Look with Fr. Kevin

The Ascension: Called to Follow and Lead Others

Imagine going to a cemetery, expecting to find the gravestone of a loved one, only to find that the grave is open and empty. How would you feel? Anger, despair, sadness. This is how Mary Magdalene and the other disciples felt on that first Easter morning.



They were confronted with something so amazing that it would take much time for reality to sink in. lesus was not taken but he was risen!

The empty tomb is not just a historical fact, but a declaration from God. Our worst enemy and our worst fear, death, has lost its power over us. This moment is the turning point of all human history, and the world has begun to be remade. Hope now has the final word!

Joseph, a Christian refugee from South Sudan, lost his home, family members, and livelihood in the civil war. While living in a refugee camp, a local missionary shared the Gospel and invited him to an Easter sunrise service. Joseph said: "When I heard that Jesus rose from the dead, I realized I was not abandoned. If God brought life out of a tomb, He can bring purpose out of my pain." Today, Joseph helps build schools in refugee camps, clinging to resurrection hope in the face of despair.

When we feel abandoned, broken, or that there is no hope, God is writing our resurrection story. God still moves stones away. He brings life where there was once death. Nothing and no situations are out of God's reach to bring healing and hope. The empty tomb is not just a historical fact. For each of us today, it is our reason to hope. All that we fear will never have the last word. He is risen! And that changes everything!

FISHAWACK!

As we have for decades, Parcells Council of the Knights of Columbus will be selling sausage & peppers sandwiches at this year's Fishawack Festival on Saturday, June 14, in Chatham Borough. The day is one of games and rides around the train station for children, and all kinds of vendors in the streets and parking lots.

Fishawack was the Lenni Lenape Native American name for the Passaic River. Chatham was located at the river's narrowest part, making it the "Crossing of the Fishawack in the Valley of the Great Watchung," according to John T. Cunningham's book, "Chatham at the Crossing of the Fishawack." Each year the tribes forded the river in Chatham enroute to their summer "getaway" at the Jersey shore where the warmer climate provided plentiful fish to eat.


