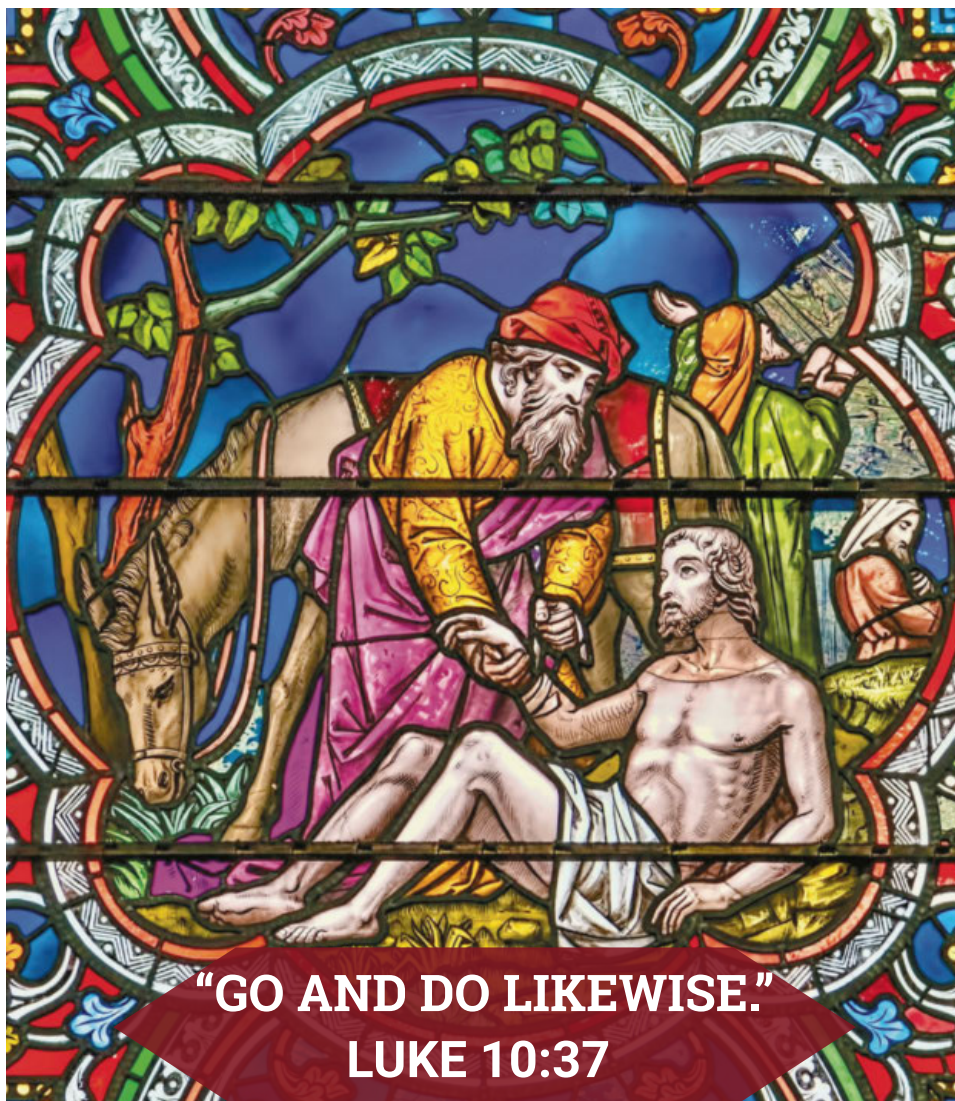

I continue to be deeply moved by the dedication and sacrifice of the parents and grandparents in our parish. So many of you work tirelessly to provide your children with every opportunity—ensuring they receive a strong education, develop meaningful social skills, and acquire the tools they'll need to thrive in the world. Your love is evident in the care you take to prepare them for a successful life.

Yet, amid all these efforts, I ask: what greater gift can we offer our children than a living relationship with God? It is for this very relationship that each of us was created. Nothing else—not achievement, nor comfort, nor acclaim—can satisfy the deepest longings of the human heart. Only this gift, the gift of faith, can sustain us through every season of life: in joy and in sorrow, in sickness and in health, in abundance and in need. It is the one treasure that promises happiness not only in this life, but for all eternity.

I remain profoundly grateful to my own parents and to the catechists who, during my childhood in Dover, stepped forward to hand on the Faith. Now, as I look back, I do so with awe and thanksgiving—for those early seeds of grace, sown in simple acts of witness and teaching, have borne fruit that continues to shape my life to this day.

Right now, our parish needs catechists and assistant catechists beginning in September to help pass on the great gift of Faith to the youth of our parish. Our Minister of Family Faith Formation, Diane, and our Youth Minister, Jim, can help get you started. Training will be provided. Maybe God is tapping you on the shoulder to step forward! The Jubilee Year with Father James

The Jubilee of Artists



The Jubilee of Artists, celebrated in February, was a moment to consider the artists who illuminate the human spirit through beauty and imagination. In every age, the Catholic Church has turned to artists to give shape to the invisible and to lift our hearts in liturgy and prayer.

Pope Benedict XVI frequently spoke of how sacred music, art, and architecture can affect the soul and lift it toward the mystery of God. In his "Address to Artists" in the Sistine Chapel on November 21, 2009, he spoke about beauty's role in the new evangelization. He called on artists to be "custodians of beauty" and taught how artists participate in divine creativity. That speech was given ten years after St. John Paul II's "Letter to Artists" (1999), in which he wrote, "Beauty is a key to the mystery and a call to transcendence. It is an invitation to savour life and to dream of the future" (par. 26). Both letters are worth reading in their entirety.

The *via pulchritudinis*, or "way of beauty," complements the *via veritatis* (way of truth) and *via bonitatis* (way of goodness), forming a trio through which the human heart is drawn to God. For example, a painting by Caravaggio or a sculpture by Michelangelo are like theological texts. They can be read not just with the eyes, but with the soul. Here lies a challenge for the modern visitor to museums and churches: to contemplate, not to consume. In our rushed age of smartphones and selfies, we risk missing what these works are meant to offer: silence, awe, thought, and contemplation. Rather than rushing through a museum just to "hit" all the masterpieces before moving on to the next thing, a museum can become a place of contemplation and divine encounter. This is why the Church has always been a patron of the arts. Sacred beauty evangelizes not through argument, but through splendor. In a disillusioned world, where many are closed off to God's revealed truth and skeptical even of goodness itself, beauty remains a gentle yet influential evangelist. It does not argue; it attracts. But only if we stop long enough to see it. So next time you're in a museum, a church, or even surrounded by the beauty of nature, don't rush. Choose one work of art and sit before it for a while. Ask not just what it depicts, but what it reveals.

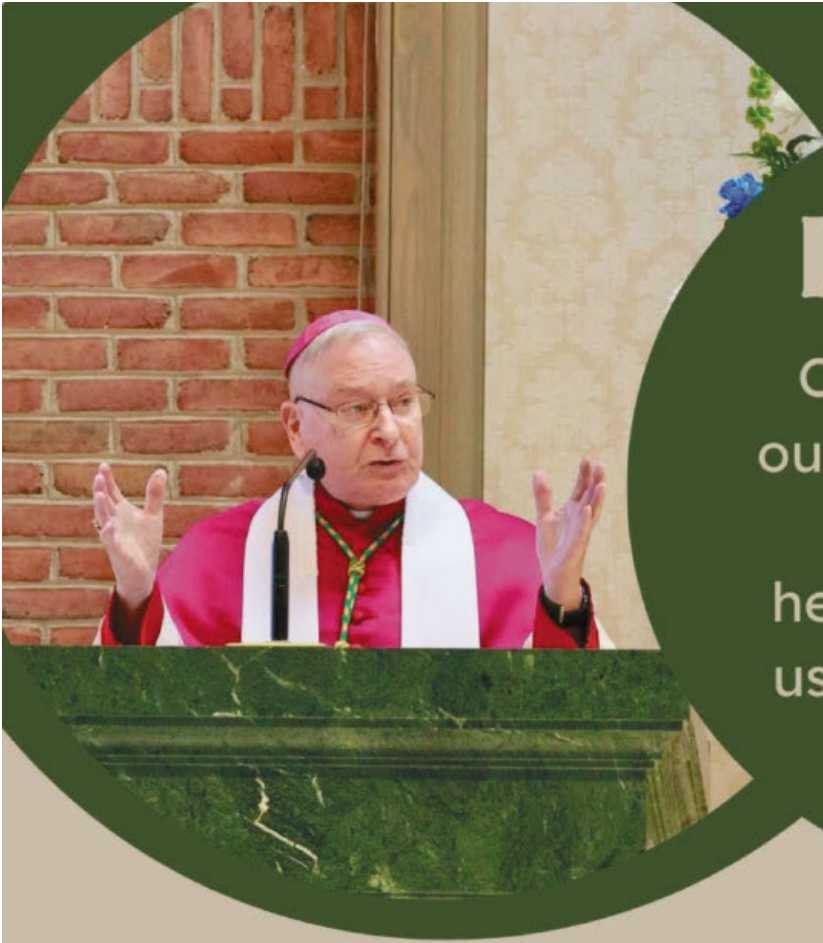

Discover the Grace of the Jubilee: A Guide to Plenary Indulgences in 2025

During the Ordinary Jubilee Year of 2025, called by the late Pope Francis, the faithful can obtain a plenary indulgence - the remission of all temporal punishment due to sin - either for themselves or for the souls in Purgatory.

Requirements for Obtaining the Plenary Indulgence

All the faithful must be:

- Passing through a Holy Door
- Free of attachment to sin
- Purified through the Sacrament of Penance
- Refreshed by Holy Communion
- Pray for the intentions of the Pope

Various Ways to Obtain the Indulgence in the Diocese of Paterson

Through Pilgrimage

Visit any designated Jubilee site in the Diocese and participate in one of these devotions:

- Holy Mass
- Celebration of the Word of God
- Liturgy of the Hours
- Stations of the Cross

Visit a Jubilee site and devoutly:

- Engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation

- Formation of activities on Vatican II documents
- Study of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

Special Provisions

Those who cannot make a pilgrimage due to serious reasons (elderly, sick, imprisoned, or caregivers) may obtain the indulgence by:

- Offering their sufferings to God
- Praying the Our Father, the Creed, and other prayers in their place of confinement

KNIGHTS' TOWER AT THE NATIONAL SHRINE


In 1959, the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC, was dedicated. One outstanding feature is the Knights' Tower, a gift from the Knights of Columbus. At 329 feet, the Knights' Tower height is second only to the Washington Monument in the District of Columbia.

Sixty-two years ago this week, the Knights blessed the Basilica with another gift: their very own carillon. On July 14, 1963, Archbishop O'Boyle consecrated the bells that were to be added to the Knights Tower, and on July 23, the carillon was successfully installed. The carillon's nine largest bells were dedicated to different saints later that year.

The Basilica continues to receive K of C financial support and manpower for chapel construction, dome mosaics, carillon upkeep and a Knights-staffed usher ministry.
