# SPECIAL COLLECTION THIS WEEKEND FOR THE SUFFERING PEOPLE OF GAZA

Upon the request of Archbishop Broglio, President of the USCCB, there will be a special diocesan collection to assist the relief efforts in Gaza. Since the beginning of his pontificate, our Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, has implored the world to turn its gaze toward Gaza. In his May 21st General Audience, the Holy Father made a personal appeal for relief: "The situation in the Gaza Strip is increasingly worrying and painful. I renew my heartfelt appeal to allow the entry of dignified humanitarian aid and to put an end to the hostilities, the heart-rending price which is being paid by children, the elderly, and the sick."

Bishop Sweeney asks that we all consider making a contribution for this important cause, which will be shared between Catholic Relief Service and the Catholic Near East Welfare Association.

Donations can be given during the second collection at all Masses or by scanning the QR code.

# FROM OUR FATHERS 03

September 7, 2025 | 23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time



### A Deeper Look With Father Kevin Growing in Faith Together

Growing up, I realized how important the family is in passing on a living faith to children. Looking back, it is interesting what stuck with me. I went to CCD in my early years, and then Catholic middle school and high school. I was in the seminary for five years. What I remember most happened in my home as a child. It was the faith of my parents, and how they lived it out day-to-day while I was growing up. Faith was always an essential piece of our life.



This weekend, we begin a new chapter in our parish Religious Education story. Last year, we changed the name from Religious Education to Family Faith Formation and let parents know that we would be moving (this year) to a new model of catechizing our young people. This new model is being used by half of the parishes in our diocese with great success, with parents and children both growing in their faith and becoming more active disciples. Bishop Sweeney felt that it was so effective that he has asked all parishes in the diocese to move to this new model.

In the past, Religious Education was about passing on the knowledge of our Catholic Faith. This new model is different. It calls parents to be more a part of their children's faith development. Together they grow together and share their faith with each other. This new model begins once a month with Mass together as a family, with the homily geared towards the children. After Mass, at least one parent will participate in faith formation in tandem with their child. The parents will learn about the theme of the day with other parents. The children will learn a lesson on their level. The two groups will then come back together to discuss what they both learned. Parents and children will complete activities and lessons the same way in their homes. Corpus Christi will empower and supply all that parents will need to be able to help their families grow in love for Jesus and the Catholic faith.

What bishops, priests, DREs and catechists have learned over the last twenty years is that a living faith is most effectively grown in children when parents are engaged, with the support of the Church.

I would like to thank Diane Vezzuto, our Minister of Family Faith Formation, for her hard work and sacrifice to get our parish ready for this new initiative. Thanks also to our parish council and our staff who assisted and supported this process. While change can seem unsettling, we are confident that we have done the necessary preparation for this new model to flourish even better than before. Like you, we want nothing less than the best for your children. We don't want our children to just know about our faith, but to grow a living relationship with Jesus that will grow and mature and assist them through every phase of their lives.

With parents and our parish working together, we are confident that this new model will bear good fruit!

# The Jubilee Year with Father James The City of God



In this Jubilee Year of Hope, we are reminded of the power of faith, resilience, and hope; especially when we face sadness. The recent tragedy at Annunciation Catholic School in Minnesota, an unspeakable event that has moved many hearts including my own, calls us to reflect deeply. For this we turn to one of the great doctors of the Church, Saint Augustine, whose feast day was recently celebrated on August 28th, to provide some guideposts for us.

In his monumental work *De Civitate Dei* (*The City of God*), Augustine speaks to the reality of human suffering in the apparent chaos of the world. For Augustine, the "City of Man" is characterized by the ego and the acquisition of temporal goods. In contrast, the "City of God" is a spiritual city, and it is to this city that the Christian should direct his or her focus. As Augustine wrote, "Two cities, then have been created by two loves: that is, the earthly by love of self, extending even to contempt of God, and the heavenly, by love of God extending even to contempt of self. The one, therefore, glories in itself, the other in the Lord; the one seeks glory from men, the other finds its highest glory in God, the Witness of our conscience. The one lifts up its head in its own glory; the other says to its God, 'Thou are my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.' [...] The one city loves its own strength as displayed by its mighty men; the other says to its God, 'I will love Thee, O Lord, my strength.'" (City of God, Book XIV, Ch. 28)

The Jubilee Year of Hope invites us to live within the framework of Augustine's vision, where we balance the reality of earthly tragedies and sin in the City of Man with faith that our true citizenship is in the City of God, ultimately to be found in the heavenly Jerusalem (cf. Phil 3:20; Heb 13:14 and Rev 21:2-4). This is an invitation to a steadfast, Christ-centered hope, that anchors us in Christian virtues. It compels us to engage in works of mercy and to offer comfort to those who are suffering. By doing so, we participate in the ongoing reality of the City of God, even while dwelling in earthly cities that so often lead us away from Christ.





#### A TESTAMENT TO UNITY

Bishop Bryan Bayda, of Eastern Canada, demonstrated the unity of Knights around the world by visiting war-torn Ukraine and its close neighbor, Poland.

He met personally with those fighting, those suffering from the war and its effects, those who have lost loved ones, and those providing aid, including fellow Knights.

In Poland, he visited two Knights of Columbus Mercy Centers which aid displaced Ukrainian children and their mothers who have been deprived of a normal family life due to the war. The centers address the material, psychological and spiritual needs of refugees.

As his journey ended, Bishop Bayda reflected on the solidarity that made the efforts of his Council - and so many other charitable works - possible. He said, "I've never been more proud to be a Knight than having been here."
