The Jubilee Year with Father James

Two New Saints for Our Time: Carlo Acutis & Pier Giorgio Frassati



Last Sunday the Church gathered in St. Peter's Square to witness the canonization of two remarkable young and modern Catholics: Carlo Acutis (1991–2006) and Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901–1925). Their canonization reminds us that holiness is fully possible in our own time, in the midst of study, work, leisure, and family. Carlo Acutis was a teenager who loved computers, soccer, and video games, yet he used those interests to share the faith, creating a website for Eucharistic miracles. When he was diagnosed with leukemia at just 15, he offered his suffering for the Church and the Pope. Pier Giorgio Frassati was a university student and mountain climber whose faith expressed itself in joy. He spent his time caring for the sick, standing up to injustice, and leading his friends closer to Christ. His motto, "Verso l'alto" ("to the heights") captured both his passion for the mountains and his desire for holiness.

During the rite of canonization, Pope Leo XIV spoke these words: "After due deliberation and frequent prayer for divine assistance and having sought the counsel of many of our brother bishops, we declare and define Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati and Carlo Acutis to be saints and we enroll them among the saints, decreeing they are to be venerated as such by the whole Church." This pronouncement did not "make" Carlo and Pier Giorgio holy, but rather recognized the holiness already present in their lives and confirmed for the faithful that they now share the fullness of divine life with God in heaven. In the Church's teaching, canonization is a pastoral gift, because it offers the faithful concrete models of holiness for imitation and intercession.

In this Jubilee Year of Hope, the canonization of Carlo and Pier Giorgio offers a profound example that holiness is attainable in every generation. These young men were not removed from the ordinary complexities of life; rather, they entered into them with the freedom of Christ. May their intercession strengthen our families and youth as we embark on this new year of Family Faith Formation, and may it renew our commitment to live as disciples of Christ in the here and now.

A Note from the Pastor: Corpus Christi 2024-2025 Financial Report



Dear Parishioners,

As your Pastor, I would like to say thank you for all that you have done throughout the past year. It is through your generosity that our parish has been able to grow and thrive. Your support and generosity allow us to provide quality programming for both adults and children, enables us to support those who are less fortunate and fix the growing number of structural issues that we face.

Part of a pastor's vocation is to ensure that the resources which you and your families have sacrificed to give us are used in a responsible manner. With that in mind, I have attached an overview of our finances for the previous fiscal year. This has been assembled by our parish finance council and Carol Scala, our Parish Administrator. Once again, the largest costs are salaries and benefits, as we have expanded our staff to serve you better. Inflation is also affecting us as it is affecting your household expenses.

Once again, the parish is faced with many structural challenges that need to be addressed. Presently we need to take care of our parish home so that it can be available for future generations. We have two roofs, the gym and the school that need to be replaced, brick work and many repairs that are too numerous to name. We will discuss these at a later date. We do have a rainy-day fund of approximately six months of expenses in order to tide us over in an emergency. I ask if you have the means to consider increasing your weekly offertory to help support our parish and the increased costs that we are incurring.

Please feel free to speak to any member of the finance council (Aidan O'Connor, Bobbie Veeder, Linda Hedden, Mark Kapsky, Paul Volovich, Carol Scala or myself) with any questions or concerns that you may have.

Once again, thank you for your generosity and unwavering support. Your gifts make it possible for our parish to continue to grow and to live out our mission of bringing Christ's joy, hope and healing to our community, now and for future generations!

A BROTHERHOOD THAT RISES IN THE STORM

Heavy rain beginning July 3 caused flooding of several major river systems in Texas. The Guadalupe River in Kerr County caused great devastation and at least 135 deaths. One local Knight lost his two daughters and parents. Five other Knights lost their homes.

The K of C Supreme Council immediately provided the Texas State Council with \$20,000 and 100 gift cards worth \$100 each for distribution to people in need. Knights from jurisdictions across the country reached out to offer help and sent more than \$100,000. The New Jersey State Council provided a check for \$13,000.

Within days, four storage facilities were filled to capacity. People were told not to bring more supplies. As one Knight noted, "It's great to see the Knights practice their faith and help their brother Knights."
