

# Congratulations Confirmandi

Congratulations to all who received the Sacrament of Confirmation at Corpus Christi Parish on September 16th and 23rd! Both celebrations were moments of grace. The joy of the Holy Spirit was visible not just in the smiles of those Confirmed, but in the faces of families, sponsors, and parishioners.



The young men and women who were confirmed have now completed their initiation into the life of the Church and are beginning their journey as active disciples. This is no small step—it's a lifelong call to walk with Christ. One of the gifts they received that day—and one that all of us who are confirmed share—is the Fear of the Lord. That phrase can sound intimidating. Some hear "fear" and immediately think of punishment. But Scripture gives us a different lens. St. John reminds us, "Perfect love casts out fear" (1 In 4:18). And Proverbs teaches, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom" (Prov 1:7).

So, what does this mean? Think of the first time you stood before something vast and powerful—maybe standing at the edge of the Grand Canyon, gazing at the ocean during a storm, or even holding your newborn child in your arms. That feeling of awe, of being small in the face of something so much greater—that's a glimpse of what "Fear of the Lord" means. It's not "fear," but reverence. It's recognizing that God is God and we are His creatures—yet creatures so deeply loved that He sent His only Son to redeem us.

We all long to be loved perfectly. Too often, we search for it in other people, who—even at their best—can only love imperfectly. Only God can fill the deepest emptiness of our hearts. When we experience His love, we don't serve Him out of fear of punishment, but out of gratitude, reverence, and love in return.

As this gift grows in us, it gives us humility, docility, and trust. We begin to see life through God's eyes, to surrender to His wisdom, and to follow Him down the path that leads not just to heaven, but to real joy even now. The gift of Fear of the Lord is not a burden—it's an invitation. An invitation to live in awe, to love in return, and to walk more closely with the One who loved us into existence!

# The Jubilee Year with Father James Saints Perpetua and Felicity



Last week we reflected on Saints Cornelius and Cyprian, who gave their lives for the Church. This week we turn to another pair of heroic saints: Perpetua and Felicity. Their story, preserved in one of the earliest Christian martyrdom accounts, is not just a historical record, but a narrative that conveys the interior faith and hope of the women themselves. I also teach this text in my course at Seton Hall University, where students read the *Passion of Perpetua and Felicity* as a testimony of Christian discipleship.

Perpetua was a young noblewoman and mother of an infant child. Felicity was a slave and pregnant at the time of her arrest. Both were catechumens preparing for baptism when they were imprisoned in Carthage at the beginning of the third century during the persecution of Emperor Septimius Severus. The narrative is remarkable because parts of it were written by Perpetua herself, offering a rare first-person account of a Christian martyr, and a female one at that. In her diary, she describes a vision of a ladder that reached up to heaven, but it was surrounded by sharp weapons. At its base lay a serpent that sought to frighten climbers away. Perpetua, however, stepped on its head and ascended through the trials to a garden of peace (cf. *Passion of Perpetua and Felicity*, 4).

In this Jubilee Year of Hope, Saints Perpetua and Felicity teach us that Christian hope is a confidence that is rooted in Christ's victory over death. Like Cornelius and Cyprian, Perpetua and Felicity point us to the truth that hope shines brightly in weakness. Their lives invite us to embrace the Gospel with courage and to live our faith with conviction.



# Nine First Fridays Devotion to The Sacred Heart of Jesus



You are invited to join us on First Friday mornings every month, starting on October 3, 2025, to participate in a special devotion. We will be starting the Sacred Heart Novena prayer at 7:25 am, followed by a 7:30 am votive Mass, to celebrate the Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

The Devotion to the Sacred Heart is a centuries-old Catholic practice centered on Jesus' deep, personal love for each of us. It focuses on His Heart not just as a symbol, but as the real, living source of divine love, mercy, and compassion. Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 1600s and revealed His Heart burning with love, asking her and all of us to "Behold this Heart which has so loved men... and is so little loved in return." He asked for a special devotion to His Sacred Heart — especially on First Fridays — to make reparation for the sins of the world and to draw souls into His merciful love. This devotion helps us to grow closer to Jesus personally, heart to heart. It helps us find peace, strength and mercy in His presence. Lastly it calls us to respond to His love with love, trust and faithfulness.

To fulfill the requirements of the Nine First Friday Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, an individual must also receive Holy Communion on the First Friday of the month for nine consecutive months, go to confession within one week each month of the First Friday, and have the intention of making reparation for the Sacred Heart of for the sins and ingratitude of humanity.

Jesus made these promises to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque regarding those who practice the Nine First Fridays and have a deep devotion to His Sacred Heart. The Twelve Promises listed below includes the "Great Promise" (number 12).

- 1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
  - 2. I will establish peace in their homes.
  - 3. I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
- 4. I will be their strength during life and above all during death.
  - 5. I will bestow a large blessing upon all their undertakings.
- 6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source and the infinite ocean of mercy.
  - 7. Tepid souls shall grow fervent.
  - 8. Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
- 9. I will bless every place where a picture of my heart shall be set up and honored.
  - 10. I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- 11. Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be blotted out.
  12. I promise you in the excessive mercy of My Heart that My all-powerful love will grant all to those who communicate on the First Friday in nine consecutive months the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their sacraments; My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

All are welcome to join us in prayer. Nine months will bring us to conclude in June, which is the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. # Watch for your Planning Study invitation


Every parish family has been mailed a personal invitation from Father Kevin to participate in the Planning Study in one of two ways:




