A Deeper Look With Father Kevin

Honoring the Creator

In this act, Jesus draws both the temple priests and His disciples into the miracle of healing and restoration—a powerful image of what He desires to do in every generation. How good our God is! Our Creator wants us to participate in His re-creating of our world.



During this month of October, we are called to remember our baptismal anointing to be vessels of healing at all stages of life. We are called as Catholics to cherish and defend life from the first moment of conception to the time that God chooses to call each person home. But this protection is not just at these two sacred moments –but also at all the moments in between.

Here in our parish, we see this lived out beautifully. Our St. Vincent de Paul Society and parish volunteers bring compassion to nursing homes. This weekend, our Chargers community begins another season for teens and adults with special learning needs. Our parish continues to serve lunch once a month at Eva's Village in Paterson. Our team of volunteers brings Communion to our homebound weekly. These are just a few of the ways that we are honoring and cherishing life at every age and circumstance.

Next weekend, October 25/26, we will conduct the Diocesan Ministries Appeal collection at all masses. This is a wonderful opportunity to join with the other 107 parishes of our diocese to support this vital initiative. Our diocesan Catholic Charities is a model for other dioceses around the country in how effective we are together in helping tens of thousands of people in our diocese who are silently in need! Together, we continue to make this possible.

At the conclusion of the Gospel story, one of the healed men—a Samaritan—returns to thank Jesus, not only for his physical healing but for his complete restoration and renewal. His gratitude reminds us to recognize God's goodness in our own lives —in the gifts we've received, the people who surround us, and the promise of eternal life. Let us respond with thankful hearts by cherishing and protecting life in all its forms and stages. None of us can do everything, but each of us can do something, and in doing so, we honor the Creator!

The Jubilee Year with Father James

Dilexi Te and the Blindness of Comfort



In recent weeks, I have reflected on what I called "the blindness of comfort", the way material ease can narrow our moral vision, and on gratitude as a way to overcome it. If we see with the eyes of faith, gratitude can mature into solidarity with others. This movement from gratitude to compassion stands at the center of Pope Leo XIV's first apostolic exhortation, *Dilexi Te* ("I Have Loved You"). Building upon the legacy of Pope Francis, Pope Leo teaches that love for God and love for the poor go hand in hand.

Leo's teaching on the parable of the rich man and Lazarus highlights that the sin of the rich man was not cruelty but indifference (cf. *Dilexi*, §87). Comfort can make us incapable of seeing the suffering around us because it shelters us from it. As Pope Leo writes, "Not infrequently, our prosperity can make us blind to the needs of others, and even make us think that our happiness and fulfillment depend on ourselves alone, apart from others. In such cases, the poor can act as silent teachers for us, making us conscious of our presumption and instilling within us a rightful spirit of humility" (*Dilexi*, §108).

In this Jubilee Year of Hope, the Pope's words call us to examine both our personal and ecclesial vision. Do we truly see those who are materially, spiritually or emotionally impoverished at our gates? Do our parish, ministries and personal choices reflect the self-emptying love of Christ? The Jubilee invites us to recover sight through encounter: to look into the faces of the poor and find there the reflection of the Crucified Lord Jesus.

Dear Corpus Christi Families,

Due to construction issues in the gym and roof repair activities, Corpus Christi will not be participating in the 2025-2026 Paterson Diocese CYO season. The gym has been successfully stabilized, and the roof repair work is expected to start later in October. The roof and gutters will be replaced, and so the gym will not be available for use until November.

These circumstances prevent us from registering players and teams for the 2025-2026 CYO season.

As an alternative, we will be opening the gym on various weeknights during the winter for skills-based basketball and open gym where players can play pick-up games, knock-out or 21 and continue to develop their basketball skills and friendships in the presence of the Lord.
