

## A Deeper Look With Father Kevin

### ***Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children***



The Prophet Jeremiah 1:5 tells us: "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born, I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations." What an awesome thing to reflect on. God knows and loves us before our parents even met. He is not distant. He is not passive. Throughout our lives, no matter what happens to us along the way, God is with us—journeying with us, watching over us, caring for us.

The Prophet Jeremiah was consecrated in the womb with a special mission in our world. In the same way, we are consecrated by God in the womb for a unique and unrepeatable mission. Only you can fill in one particular piece in the lives of others and in the world around you. You matter. Your life has purpose, even when we may feel invisible. Our life is of great value—despite our struggles, our sacrifices, our yearnings, which often no one else can see. God sees. God knows. God loves!

On January 22<sup>nd</sup>, we celebrate a Day of Prayer of the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. It is a time to remember the great gift of life that God gives us—from conception to natural death. We are called to care for, protect, and defend the lives of all our brothers and sisters, especially those who are most vulnerable and those who are marginalized. In doing so, we help others live out their sacred mission.

When we protect and cherish life at all stages, we see glimmers of the divine shining through frail humanity, reminding us of our own dignity before God and others, and the supernatural mission that we each participate in. It is then that we are reminded: we are loved at each stage of life. In imitation of God, let us love and journey with others in each stage of their lives.

## Reflections with Father James

### ***On Time and Fulfillment***



Preaching should begin from dogma. For Pope Benedict XVI, this was never an abstract principle. What the Church confesses should shape how the Church speaks, and how Christians live within time. At the center stands the confession that Jesus Christ is true God and true man. Because of this, time is neither closed in on itself nor without purpose. History has a direction because God has entered it. In *Introduction to Christianity*, Ratzinger reflects on this consequence of the Incarnation:

"Christian faith does not proclaim a timeless idea, but an event. It does not speak of an eternal cycle, but of a history that has meaning because God has acted within it. The Incarnation anchors time in God himself. From that moment on, time is no longer merely passing away; it is moving toward fulfillment. What has been lived is not lost, and what is awaited is already anticipated, because the eternal has entered the temporal." (Joseph Ratzinger, *Introduction to Christianity*, 227-228).

As the year unfolds, the Church invites us to live our time in this light, confident that every moment is drawn into God's saving work in Christ.

### STAUNCHLY PRO-LIFE


Rooted in Church teachings, the Knights of Columbus are staunchly pro-life. We defend the sanctity of human life in all stages, from conception through natural death.

### ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY




