



Update on the Capital Campaign



This past fall, I invited our parish family to participate in a parish-wide survey conducted by Guidance in Giving. I am very grateful to all who took the time to respond prayerfully and thoughtfully. The results were deeply encouraging and reflected a strong love for our parish and a shared desire to plan carefully for its future.

With the assistance of Guidance in Giving, we are continuing this important work by gathering additional information, evaluating available options, and seeking bids where appropriate. In addition, I have invited several parishioners—Hugo Barth, Janet Barth, and Kevin Zerrenner—to serve on a Capital Campaign Leadership Team. They will work closely with me, our parish staff, and Guidance in Giving throughout this process.

Together, this team will help identify our highest-priority needs, assist with thoughtful planning and oversight, and ensure that all funds raised are managed wisely, responsibly, and transparently. This period of preparation is an essential step, allowing us to move forward with care and good stewardship as we address necessary capital improvements to our church, parish community spaces, and rectory.

I see this process not simply as planning for buildings or projects, but as a time of discernment—asking how we can best support the mission of our parish, strengthen our ministries, and ensure that our parish remains a welcoming place of worship, prayer, and service for years to come. I ask for your continued prayers as this work progresses and for your patience as we take the time needed to do it well.

With hope and trust in God's providence, we look toward beginning a parish capital campaign after Easter this year (April 5th). The Easter season reminds us that God is always bringing new life and renewal. May we continue to walk forward together in faith, united as one parish family, grateful for all that God is doing among us!

Reflections with Father James

On Time and Attention



Time is where our lives take place. It is the space in which God addresses us and draws us forward into his eternity.

Modern life encourages efficiency and constant movement. Days are often measured by output and deadlines. This reality can even enter our churches. The Catholic tradition invites a different posture. Time is first received by the soul as a sacred gift.

Ratzinger returned often to this theme. Because God has entered history in Jesus Christ, time carries weight and direction. Each moment belongs within a story shaped by God's presence. When we attend to time properly, we learn to remain with the present moment and to recognize how God works patiently.

Ordinary Time provides a steady rhythm for this way of living. The Church slows our pace and trains us to live each day well. In doing so, she teaches us to trust the gradual work of God. When time is received as gift, each moment becomes a place of encounter with God and those around us.

MORE IMPORTANT THAN THE SCORE

At the 126th annual Army-Navy football game last month, more than 60,000 people watched cadets and midshipmen face off in one of college football's most storied rivalries. But when the action paused at halftime, college Knights from both military academies organized a display of spiritual strength: leading dozens of others in praying a rosary, a public witness to their faith.

Cadets from West Point and midshipmen from Annapolis huddled with over 200 other people in the stadium concourse to pray.






