

## A Deeper Look With Father Kevin

### *Our Lenten Journey - Hearts Set on God*



This Wednesday, February 18, is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the Lenten season. Lent can be one of the most grace-filled times in the Church calendar if we choose. It is an opportunity to reflect on God's unwavering love for us. Lent is also about us reflecting on our personal commitment in response to such great love!

Over the year, our hearts, minds and actions lose focus. We allow God to move out of the primary place in our life and let other lesser goods become our focus. We all sin and do things that hurt our relationship with God and others. It is easy to feel comfortable and justify wherever we are in our spiritual journey. Lent helps us together to refocus our lives to be totally honest before God, ourselves, and others. *And to return to our first Love!*

On Ash Wednesday, when we receive ashes on our foreheads, we are told to "turn from sin and be faithful to the Gospel." To do this, we focus more on prayer, penance, and helping the poor. We spend more time in prayer and intentionally give to those who are poor, reminding us that we are indeed our brothers' and sisters' keepers. It is appropriate to think of something that we can give up to remind us of our greatest need -for God.

Catholics are asked to go to Confession at least one time a year. Lent is a perfect opportunity to do this. Our parish offers Confession on Mondays in Lent in the atrium conference room from 7:00 PM to 8:30 PM. You can also call the office to schedule a time for confession outside of these times. We are also asked to make small sacrifices such as at certain times fasting and abstaining from meat. The norms of fasting are for those aged 18 to age 59. The rule of abstinence from meat is for Catholics aged 14 and older. *(See the Guidelines for Fasting and Abstinence during Lent on page 06)*

As we make this journey together, we remember that all these intentional practices have one purpose in mind -- to empty our hearts and lives to make room for God's great love, to allow God to remove the obstacles, so that we can experience God's joy, hope, and healing and share it with others!

## Reflections with Father James

### *Stretch Out Your Hand*



"[God] has set before you fire and water to whichever you choose, stretch forth your hand. Before man are life and death, good and evil, whichever he chooses shall be given him" (Sir 15:17).

The spiritual life is shaped through decisions. Each day presents moments where we move closer to God or move away from Him.

St. Gregory of Nyssa describes this process:

"Human nature is always in motion and never remains fixed. It is continually being changed into what it chooses. By its inclinations it takes on the form of what it loves. If it inclines toward the good, it grows in goodness and becomes more radiant. If it turns toward what is base, it is darkened and takes on the likeness of what is inferior. Thus, the soul is fashioned according to its choices, and the direction of the will becomes the form of the life" (*The Life of Moses*, Part II, 2-3).

We do not remain the same from one day to the next. Each decision leaves a mark. God gives us freedom, and he also gives us the grace to choose. This week, pay attention to one situation where a deliberate choice is needed. In that moment, remember the image from Sirach. Will you stretch out your hand towards water or flame? Over time, the life you choose becomes the person you become.

## Guidelines for Fasting & Abstinence

---

**Roman Catholics are asked to abstain from meat** on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all Fridays during Lent. The rule is for Catholics aged 14 and above, unless there are mitigating health concerns. In this case, one can do a good work in place of this.

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, we are also asked to **fast** (those 18 to 59). Fasting means a person is permitted to eat one full meal during the day. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but they are not to equal that of a full meal. For those with mitigating health issues who are unable to fast and/or abstain, one can do a good work in place of this.

While those are the only two days of full fasting and abstinence required, all of Lent should be a time of **spiritual formation and preparation** for Easter. Also recommended are spiritual activities, such as spending more time studying the Scriptures, attending Mass more frequently, as well as the traditional Lenten Devotions (Stations of the Cross, Bible studies, Lenten talks, and the Rosary), and other acts of sacrifice such as reaching out to those in need around us. All these activities help us together to refocus our lives towards what is most important.



## A WONDERFUL ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY STORY

During their January meeting, the members of the Corpus Christi Church Saint Vincent de Paul Society began discussing the scourge of homelessness in our nation. One member who often travels for business mentioned that he was aware of a homeless couple who apparently were living in one of the waiting areas of Newark Airport. The member reported that he had seen the couple numerous times as he made his way through the busy terminal.

Upon hearing of the homeless couple, the Saint Vincent de Paul group expressed sympathy. One gentleman became particularly interested and asked many questions. This gentleman and the member who had reported seeing the homeless individuals then agreed to meet a day or two later and together go to visit the couple at the airport. This they did, and they quickly befriended "Jake" and "Sandy" (not their real names). As with many homeless individuals, the first emotion that Jake and Sandy expressed was gratitude that the two men had recognized them as living, viable human beings. When asked how our Saint Vincent de Paul Society might help them, they mentioned that they needed toiletries and a change of clothing. The Saint Vincent de Paul members informed their colleagues in the church group of the situation and then procured the needed items (using the funds given them by the parishioners of Corpus Christi Church). Jake and Sandy were most grateful!

Upon returning to the airport a few days later, and continuing to build a relationship with Jake and Sandy, the Saint Vincent de Paul representatives discovered that the couple actually had an opportunity to begin renting an apartment and move out of the airport, but they were barred from doing so because they were both addicted to illegal substances. Upon learning this, the representatives connected the couple with the Diocese of Paterson Catholic Charities' Straight and Narrow Program located in Paterson. Both were thrilled to be admitted.

Just this past week, one of the representatives who had initially gone to Newark Airport again visited Jake and Sandy at Straight and Narrow to extend friendship and support. Seeing that they had been wearing, for several weeks straight, the same clothing that had been given them, he, with the strong encouragement of the other members of the Saint Vincent de Paul Society, expended additional funds (all provided by Corpus Christi parishioners) for fresh clothing, shoes, and toiletries. Again, the couple expressed gratitude and emphasized their goal of completing the program in which they are enrolled so they might obtain an apartment of their own, gain employment, and begin a new life.

The Saint Vincent de Paul Society simply aims to do good works in our troubled world. We are deeply grateful for the prayers and financial support of the generous people of Corpus Christi Parish.




