



A Deeper Look With Father Kevin

First Sunday of Lent



On this first Sunday in Lent, after his baptism, Jesus is driven out into the desert for 40 days. Jesus was tempted to take the easy path, to rely on himself, to use his gifts and powers for himself and his needs only. Jesus resisted these temptations!

During Lent, we are called to journey together into the desert to be by ourselves and honestly see how we are living, who we are living for, and where God fits into our lives. We are all tempted to just keep doing what we do for the rest of the year and avoid these questions.

Yet when we use all that, the Church provides for us during this season, we journey with Jesus through this time in the desert and make great progress in our journey towards heaven. Extra prayer, giving to the poor, using Confession, reading the Bible more, trying to reestablish relationships that are broken, and fasting. All these practices help us to put God back in first place in our lives, put others second and help us to love ourselves appropriately again.

God will reward our efforts! For every step that we take towards God and others, God takes two towards us. Jesus invites us each on this journey for 40 days! Don't miss out on this grace-filled opportunity!

Reflections with Father James

The Desert and the Recovery of Trust



The first move of the serpent in Genesis 3 is a spiritual one. He plants suspicion about the fatherhood of God. Once Eve starts to imagine God as a rival, disobedience begins to look like freedom. This weekend's Gospel places Jesus in the desert to meet that same ancient lie with power. In the wilderness, Jesus refuses to test the Father. He stands in the truth, and he stands there as the new Adam, repairing what was broken at the beginning.

Saint Irenaeus explains this well, by putting the fall and redemption in dialogue:

"As through a disobedient virgin man was stricken down and fell into death, so through the Virgin, who was obedient to the word of God, man was revived and received life. For the Lord came to seek back again the lost sheep; and it was man who was lost. And, therefore, he did not become any other being but man, thus taking up the ancient creation, that he might kill sin, deprive death of its power, and vivify mankind" (*Against Heresies*, Book III).

Lent leads us into this recovery of trust. Jesus in the desert is not only our example; he is also our Savior who fights our battles for us. In Lent, we remember that his victory becomes ours, and the Father's trustworthiness can then be believable again in the depths of our souls.

LENT AND THE KNIGHTS

Fraternity is how Knights value the brotherhood and solidarity we and our families share. We know that sometimes that requires patience, abstaining from a hasty word or angry remark. In a word, we practice **fasting** from that which undermines our fraternity.

Parish Council Candidate Requirements

The role of the Corpus Christi Parish Council:

Ideal Candidates

- Embody the Parish Vision (Christ's Joy, Hope, and Healing Received and Shared) and Parish Mission through service to the parish community.
- Have a personal commitment to an active prayer/faith life.
- Are willing to contribute individual talents/skills and treasure to the best of his/her ability.



Requirements to be a candidate for the September 2026 - May 2029 term:

- Have been a registered member of the Parish for at least 6 months
- Have received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation*
- Are willing to serve a 3-year term, and are available to attend Council meetings** (held on Saturday mornings, five (5) sessions per year, September through June)
- Participate in some aspects of Parish life

*or are a teen preparing for confirmation **teens may choose to serve a 2-year term

Note: nominations will be accepted until March 9th and then closed.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY

On February 15, we discussed how Jesus tells us we must not try to get angry with our brothers and sisters or call them names; and if we argue, we need to try to make up with them. We believe we are all part of God's family and we are all brothers and sisters, and we need to treat others as we want to be treated. Even though the person to our left and right look different than us, we are all special in God's eyes. If we look at the differences instead of coming together, that could cause arguments and problems. We talked about the special gifts that we have and being true to God. Our yes should be yes, and no should be no, so that God knows we are trustworthy. We decorated hearts with yes on one side and no on the other. This week, the children are encouraged to try not to argue with anyone and if they do, to please make up with them, and to choose love.
