

## A Deeper Look With Father Kevin

### *Our Deepest Thirst*



In 1914, during the early days of World War I, a young British soldier named Henry Tandey showed mercy to a wounded German soldier on the battlefield. The man was injured and defenseless. Tandey raised his rifle, but instead of shooting, he lowered it and allowed the soldier to walk away. Years later, historians suggested that the wounded soldier he spared may have been Adolf Hitler. Whether every detail of the story is certain or not, the story illustrates something powerful: small moments of decision can have enormous consequences—often far beyond what we can see at the time.

That idea actually helps us understand today's Gospel from John. Jesus heals a man who had been blind from birth. But the story quickly becomes about much more than a miracle. The religious leaders begin interrogating him. They question him again and again. They question his parents. They question the facts. Eventually they even throw him out of the synagogue.

Why? Because they had already decided what they believed about Jesus. And once they made up their minds, they refused to reconsider—even when the evidence was right in front of them.

One of the most striking moments comes when the man who was healed says to them, almost in disbelief, "This is what is so amazing—you don't know where he is from, yet he opened my eyes."

The real problem wasn't that there wasn't enough evidence. The real problem was closed hearts.

And that can happen to us too. Sometimes we make up our minds about people or situations. We think, "That person will never change," or "Nothing good can come from that," or "God can't possibly be working there." And once we decide, we stop looking.

But the man who was healed stayed open. Little by little his understanding grew. At first, he calls Jesus simply "the man called Jesus." Later he says Jesus must be a prophet. And finally, when he meets Jesus again, he says, "Lord, I believe."

The Gospel gently reminds us that faith requires an openness. God often works in ways we don't expect, through people we didn't anticipate, and at times we didn't plan. If we stay humble and open—like the man who was healed—we may discover that God has been at work right in front of us.

## Holy Triduum 2026

### April

#### 2 Holy Thursday

##### 8:30 am Morning Prayer

Come and pray the Liturgy of the Hours, the ancient prayer of the Universal Church. Rooted in Scripture—especially the Psalms—this beautiful, structured prayer nourishes us and sets the rhythm of our day as we meditate on the history of our salvation.

##### 7:30 pm Mass of the Lord's Supper (livestreamed)

##### ~ Adoration until 10 pm

The Mass of the Lord's Supper celebrates the institution of the Eucharist and Priesthood and highlights Christ's call to loving service through the washing of the feet. This liturgy begins the

Holy Triduum and concludes with the procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the altar of repose, recalling Jesus' prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane.

#### 3 Good Friday of the Lord's Passion

##### 8:30 am Morning Prayer

Come and pray the Liturgy of the Hours, meditating on our salvation, especially the redemptive suffering of Jesus on the Cross.

##### 3:00 pm Liturgy of the Lord's Passion (livestreamed)

On Good Friday, the Church celebrates the redemptive death of Jesus on the Cross. We meditate on the Lord's Passion and Jesus' Cross is venerated during the liturgy as we pray for the needs of the whole world.

##### 7:00 pm Stations of the Cross

The Stations are prayed on the evening of Christ's death. We solemnly journey with Christ through his passion and death.

#### 4 Holy Saturday

##### 11:00 am Blessing of Easter Food

A simple tradition where parishioners bring their Easter food to be blessed, sharing in the joy and hope of the Resurrection.

##### 12:30 pm Easter Egg Hunt

Easter is almost here! Join us for a fun egg hunt to celebrate.

##### 8:00 pm Easter Vigil Mass (livestreamed)

On this holy night, the Church keeps watch and celebrates Christ's Resurrection—the turning point of the Holy Triduum and the passage from death to life. This is the most sacred and beautiful liturgy of the year.

This is considered a period of purification and enlightenment before the Elect receive Baptism at the Easter Vigil. 40 CANS FOR LENT

In September 2010, Dennis Chaput heard God ask him to start a food drive with a simple but effective format: inviting parishioners and other members of the community to donate one grocery item for every day of Lent.

Since then, the idea of a "40 Cans for Lent" food drive has been adopted by K of C councils from Maine to Alaska. Chaput's council alone has collected over 241,000 pounds of food and more than \$59,000 in monetary donations for their Archdiocese's Catholic Charities.

Councils get creative in their drives. One council has theme weekends, designating different Sundays of Lent as "Peanut Butter Sunday," "Mac 'n' Cheese Sunday" and so on. Other councils involve local Catholic schools, teaching the students to give service and demonstrate love for their community.
