## A Deeper Look With Father Kevin

### *Becoming Fully Alive*



In the Gospel Jesus says something very powerful: *"I am the resurrection and the life."* What does that mean?

St. Irenaeus once said, *"The glory of God is a human being fully alive."* In many ways, that phrase captures the heart of Christianity. What gives God joy is when we are fully alive. And what saddens the heart of God is when we allow sin or death to take hold of us—spiritually, emotionally, or psychologically. When sin begins to dwell within us, this grieves God.

In the first reading from the prophet Ezekiel, God says, "I will open your graves and have you rise from them." Sometimes we find ourselves living in graves of our own making—hatred, resentment, jealousy, or an inability to forgive. These things can limit our lives and hold us bound. Even our small sins add up over time.

That image comes alive in the story of Lazarus. Lazarus has been in the tomb for four days. When Jesus tells them to move the stone, Martha says there will be "a stench." St. Augustine said Lazarus represents the kind of spiritual rot that has become habitual in our lives—when anger or resentment has settled in so deeply that it begins affecting others. In those places, he says, we may begin "to stink."

Yet the heart of the Gospel is that Jesus comes even to the tomb. Even to the worst places in our lives. And there He calls Lazarus back to life. Sometimes people say, "What I've done is too bad to be forgiven." The Gospel tells us clearly: no one is beyond the reach of God.

At the tomb Jesus groans, because it pains God to see us trapped in woundedness and unable to flourish. Then Jesus says, "Take away the stone... Lazarus, come out." Today He speaks those same words to each of us. Because we were not made for the grave. We were made to be fully alive!

# Join Us for Holy Week & Easter!

## **Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, March 29** **Masses at 5:00 pm\* (Saturday);** **7:30, 8:45, 11:00 am\* & 6:00 pm (Sunday)**

Holy Week begins with the waving of palms as we welcome Jesus into Jerusalem. We read the Lord's Passion at all Masses and blessed palms are distributed as we begin this most sacred week in our liturgical calendar.

## **Holy Wednesday, April 1**

### **7:30 pm\* Tenebrae - Music & Meditation**

Tenebrae means "darkness" or "shadows." Through Scripture and hymns, we accompany Jesus in his final hours, extinguishing seven candles until the church is in darkness - a sign of the growing sorrow of Passion Week.

## **Holy Thursday, April 2**

### **8:30 am Morning Prayer**

Come and pray the Liturgy of the Hours, the ancient prayer of the Universal Church. Rooted in Scripture—especially the Psalms—this beautiful, structured prayer nourishes us and sets the rhythm of our day as we meditate on the history of our salvation.

### **7:30 pm\* Mass of the Lord's Supper** **~ Adoration until 10 pm**

The Mass of the Lord's Supper celebrates the institution of the Eucharist and Priesthood and highlights Christ's call to loving service through the washing of the feet. This liturgy begins the Holy Triduum and concludes with the procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the altar of repose, recalling Jesus' prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane.

## **Good Friday of the Lord's Passion, April 3**

### **8:30 am Morning Prayer**

Come and pray the Liturgy of the Hours, meditating on our salvation, especially the redemptive suffering of Jesus on the Cross.

### **3:00 pm\* Liturgy of the Lord's Passion**

On Good Friday, the Church celebrates the redemptive death of Jesus on the Cross. We meditate on the Lord's Passion and Jesus' Cross is venerated during the liturgy as we pray for the needs of the whole world.

### **7:00 pm Stations of the Cross**

The Stations are prayed on the evening of Christ's death. We solemnly journey with Christ through his passion and death.

## **Holy Saturday, April 4**

### **11:00 am Blessing of Easter Food**

A simple tradition where parishioners bring their Easter food to be blessed, sharing in the joy and hope of the Resurrection.

### **12:30 pm Easter Egg Hunt**

Easter is almost here! Join us for a fun egg hunt to celebrate.

### **8:00 pm\* Easter Vigil Mass**

On this holy night, the Church keeps watch and celebrates Christ's Resurrection—the turning point of the Holy Triduum and the passage from death to life. This is the most sacred and beautiful liturgy of the year.


