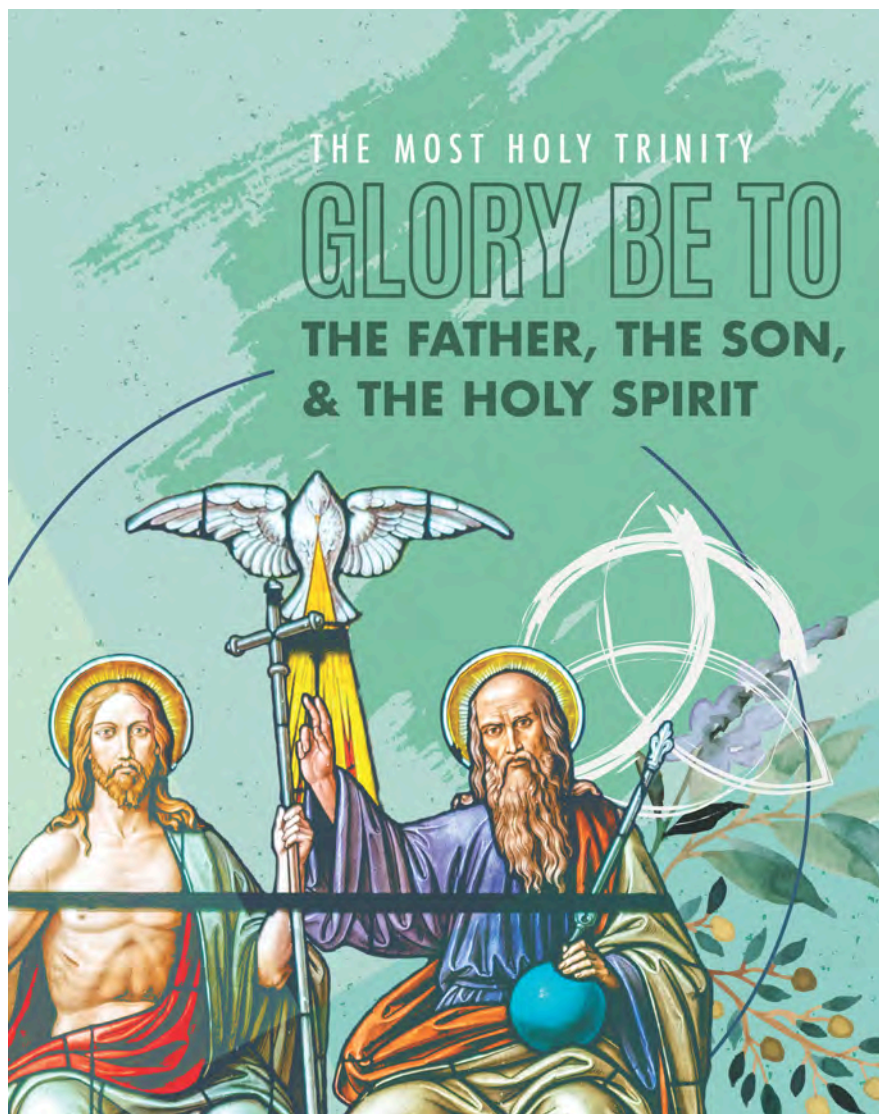

A Deeper Look With Father Kevin

Trinity Sunday



At times, we describe God as creator, provider, friend, redeemer, and counselor. These describe how God acts, but God is more than this. At the core of God, God is a Trinity of three Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

After World War II, many European families had very little. Yet historians often describe how families would still place an extra chair at the dinner table for displaced people, neighbors, or returning soldiers. Even in poverty, people understood something important: a home becomes human when there is room for someone else.

The Russian Orthodox Iconographer, Rublev, created an icon that sheds light on this mystery. In the icon, there are three Persons sitting around a table. In front of the table, facing us, is an empty spot. The three people represent the Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The three sitting around the table represent the love shared between the Persons of the Trinity. A love that has existed for all eternity. Each Person only thinks about and loves the other. There is joy and peace and perfect harmony. This is what heaven is all about. It begins now!

In the middle of the table is food in a bowl. It is an image of the Eucharist, the divine food which draws us into the very life of God. This is why it is so important to receive. The Eucharist allows us to enter into this divine mystery. The empty spot is facing us for a reason. God has waited for all eternity to invite each of us to sit at this table, to share in the very life of the Trinity.

In order to sit in this spot, God asks us one thing. If he reserves a spot in his life for us, we must reserve a spot in our lives for others. We must make room in our hearts for others and see them as made in the image and likeness of the Trinity. The poor, the outcasts, the difficult to love, our enemies. We must open our hands in sharing ourselves and what we have to be a part of the solution of making a better world.

The Trinity reminds us that life is not found in closing ourselves off, but in making room for others. Every time we do that, we begin to reflect the likeness of God Himself.

As we have for decades, Parcells Council of the Knights of Columbus will be selling sausage & peppers sandwiches at this year's Fishawack Festival on Saturday, June 6, in Chatham Borough. The day is one of games and rides around the train station for children, and all kinds of vendors in the streets and parking lots.

Fishawack was the Lenni Lenape Native American name for the Passaic River. Chatham was located at the river's narrowest part, making it the "Crossing of the Fishawack in the Valley of the Great Watchung," according to John T. Cunningham's book, "Chatham at the Crossing of the Fishawack." Each year the tribes forded the river in Chatham enroute to their summer "getaway" at the Jersey shore where the warmer climate provided plentiful fish to eat.
