

The instruction is held the second Monday of each month at 7:30p.m, in the meeting room of the lower Church.

Couples planning to celebrate their marriage at St. Frances should make an appointment with a priest at least six months before their planned wedding date in order to begin their marriage preparation and reserve a date for the wedding.


