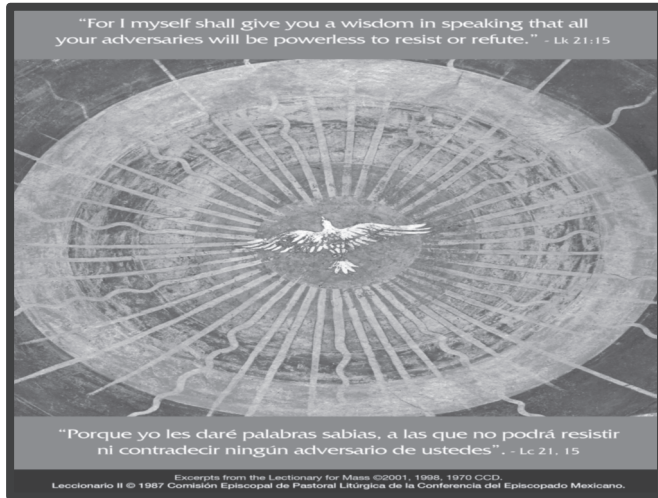

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are usually celebrated the 1st and 3rd Sundays of each month at 2:30 pm. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Frances must make arrangements with a priest at the rectory. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Education Instruction. The instruction is usually held the second Monday of each month at 7:30p.m, in the meeting room of the lower Church. Godparents must be practicing Catholics in a parish and have received the sacraments. Godparents, if married, must be married in the Catholic Church.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples planning to celebrate their marriage at St. Frances should make an appointment with a priest at least six months before their planned wedding date in order to begin their marriage preparation and reserve a date for the wedding.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

Members of the parish who wish to receive the Anointing of the Sick or have Holy Communion brought to the homebound should contact the rectory. In case of emergency, please call the rectory at any time.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

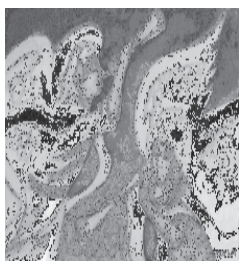

Dear Parishioners,

We are happy to say that the Young Teen Group is working hard on their annual Lip Sync Competition for December 3. Members of the group will be in the Lower Church next week after all of the Masses to sell t-shirts and to give tickets to those who request them. Seating is limited so it is best to get your tickets now! ... The Sisters of Life will be helping us with the Holy Hour on December 8th following the 7 pm Mass for the Immaculate Conception --- it will be a time of prayer, music and the opportunity to go to Confession (in English or in Spanish). All are welcome.

We are about finished with our cement work near the school, in front of the church and near the rectory. We will do more in the future when we have more funds. You are asked to bring non-perishable foods for the Little Sisters of the Poor and their residence for Thanksgiving. Details are in the bulletin announcements (please check the expiration dates!) ... On Saturdays, the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament beginning at 4 pm will be in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel, there will be a group praying the Rosary about 20 minutes before Mass and the priests will be able to suggest some prayer in the Chapel as a possible penance after confessions. The main church is busy setting up for Mass, posting the hymn numbers and making sure books are set --- the Chapel is much more conducive to prayer and meditation before the Blessed Sacrament.

The year of mercy is coming to an end at Advent. How have you been doing with the corporal and spiritual acts of mercy?

Again, a reminder to come to church a few minutes before Mass and to prepare for the Mass by reading the Scriptures and prayers. The number of people arriving late is very distracting to the people and the priests. Thanks for your cooperation.

Thank you for your continuing support of the parish through the Sunday envelopes. Hopefully you can see that your donations are being well-spent in repairing, renovating and restoring so much of the parish property --- we will keep up the good work and we ask you to keep up your generosity.

MASS SCHEDULE CHANGE

As I have mentioned before, all parishes have been asked to review their Mass schedules and the Cardinal is encouraging all parishes to consider fewer Masses on the weekends with a greater number of parishioners at fewer Mass. Hopefully, this will improve the quality and active participation at each Mass when we are together with more parishioners. Our East Bronx cluster of churches has the following Sunday evening Masses --- all very local --- St. Theresa at 5 pm on Sundays, Our Lady of the Assumption at 6 pm on Sundays, St. Benedict at 7 pm on Sunday --- and so we will be discontinuing our Sunday Mass at 6 pm at Frances as of Sunday, December 18. St. Benedict's Parish has discontinued its Spanish Mass and parishioners are encouraged to come to our Spanish Mass on Sundays at 1 pm. These minor changes seem to make great sense when we have fewer priests, fewer people coming to so many Masses and the need for a Mass in another language. Please note our change and thank you for your understanding as things change.

REMINDER

Please be on time for the Masses --- walking in late is a distraction to others; come early for some extra prayers, stay a while after Mass for some extra prayers; for our hymns, we use the red hymnal (WORSHIP) which are on the carts at the back of the church --- please take a copy each Sunday; the readings and the psalm response are found in the paper missalettes in each pew --- please use them to follow the Mass. Using these will certainly help you to pray and to appreciate the Mass more fully. It is always great to see parents and grandparents showing the children how to follow the Mass and to sing the hymns ... keep up the good work.

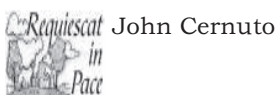

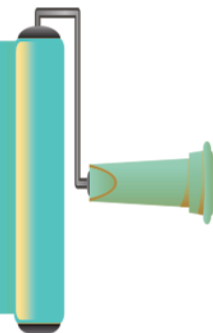
