SOME UPDATES ... the repair of the church tower has been authorized and the Archdiocese has selected a construction company for the job ... their selection is usually the better way to go in case there are any issues or insurance claims on such a project ... the parish will be responsible for paying for the repairs and thanks to the generosity of our parishioners we have \$43,636 in restricted funds (this includes the donation of the Holy Name Society from the recent Bingo) ... additional donations will be welcomed ... the arborist (the tree doctor) is surveying the property for dead trees, hanging and dangerous branches and other landscaping issues and I foresee a proposal approaching \$20,000 for this needed property clean-up ... thanks to the tender loving care of Eddie Diaz our microphone system is having its life extended over and over again but I think it will need to be replaced in the near future ... IT NEVER ENDS!

CARDINAL'S APPEAL ... we have donations of \$30,625.49 from 70 donors ... many thanks for your generosity in this important appeal for many Archdiocesan programs --- retired priests, religious education programs, seminary support, needy parishes and Catholic Charities outreach ... the appeal is still open for additional gifts.
