





Steven Komives '65:



Celebrating the achievements and contributions of its alumni is a tradition that Elyria Catholic High School holds dear. Among its accomplished graduates, Steven Komives from the Class of 1965 stands out as a remarkable individual who has led a life filled with spiritual exploration, dedicated service to his country, and a fulfilling career in technology. Moreover, Steven continues to impact his alma mater through his generosity, utilizing his Individual Retirement Account (IRA) to make Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs) that benefit the school while minimizing his tax burden and maximizing the potential of his charitable impact.

a spiritual journey

Steven is a man grounded in spirituality and faith, which has been a cornerstone of his character since his early years. After attending Wellington schools for kindergarten through 7th grade, Komives transferred to St. Mary's Elyria, and it was during that impactful year that his parish priest at St. Patrick's Wellington and the Sisters of Notre Dame encouraged him to attend Borromeo Seminary after completing 8th grade. Komives had always been involved at his church having served as an altar boy and dedicated Saturday catechism class attendee, but after two years in the seminary he realized that religious life was not for him and he transferred to, the then, Elyria District Catholic High School.

Reflecting on his time as a seminarian, Steven shares, "My years studying to become a priest were formative for me. Although I ultimately realized it was not my path, it deepened my understanding of faith, compassion, and service."

Komives remains a passionately spiritual and faith-filled man today. He has a deep devotion to Mother Mary and visits the beautiful Sorrowful Mother Shrine in Bellevue often. He explained, "I enjoy walking the grounds,

praying through the Stations of the Cross, praying the rosary, and attending Mass in their Shrine Chapel or outdoor Pieta Chapel. The grounds are a sacred space and special to me. I encourage everyone to visit sometime. It's only an hour away and at the risk of letting the secret out I never visit Bellevue without stopping at Miller's Drive In."

service to country

After graduating Elyria Catholic, Steven pursued an array of college courses before being drafted into the Navy during the Vietnam War era. For his six years of enlistment he worked as an Electronics Communications Technician Petty Officer both at a Naval Air Station and aboard ships. Steven explains, "Serving in the Navy allowed me to continue embodying my values of discipline, duty, and teamwork. It was a pivotal experience that broadened my horizons and instilled a strong sense of patriotism within me, while providing the foundational understanding of electronics that would serve me throughout my professional career."

career in technology

After his honorable discharge from the Navy, Steven graduated from Illinois Institute of Technology with a M.S.C.S. His interest in technology led him to explore a new field: computer science. He began a successful 24-year career with AT&T/Lucent Technologies Bell Labs Innovations as an electronics engineer and software computer scientist for the company. Throughout his extensive tenure, he actively contributed to a myriad of cellular telephone systems, helping to shape today's digital landscape.

Steven reflects on his career, stating, "Technology has revolutionized the way we live and connect with one another. Being part of this transformative era was both exhilarating and fulfilling. It resonated with my love for problem-solving and pushing boundaries."

impact of Elyria Catholic High School

When reminiscing about his time at Elyria Catholic, Steven fondly recalls his involvement as a manager for the school's football team. Supporting the players and coaching staff, he witnessed firsthand the transformative power of camaraderie, teamwork, and mentorship. Such experiences left an indelible mark on Steven, reinforcing the values he still holds dear today.

Speaking about the impact of Elyria Catholic, Steven shares, "The school provided an environment that nurtured not only my academic growth but also my spiritual and personal development. It emphasized the importance of integrity, compassion, and community, values that continue shaping my decisions and actions."

contributing from the heart



Kevin Krupelak '77: Finding Inspiration in the Selflessness and Grace of Another

Giving back to Elyria Catholic was always the plan for Kevin Krupelak, from the Elyria Catholic High School Class of 1977. Kevin realized early on in his adult life that he owed a debt of gratitude to his alma mater. Having received an education that shaped his future, Kevin always wanted to find a way to give back to the school that had given him so much. Little did he know that his desire to give back would lead him to highlight the inspirational life of Frances T. Schuster.

Growing up in Elyria, Kevin Krupelak was the youngest of five Panthers. "Going to Elyria Catholic games on the weekend was just what we did so you kind of got raised into the culture there. EC was very much just part of our family. My mother actually worked in the kitchen at EC for several years and my father frequently said that one of the best things they ever did for us was sending us to EC." Kevin participated in football and track while a student at EC and for many years he held on to the dream of gifting the school a new track if he was ever in the position to do so. "Our track at Elyria Catholic was not good. It was made out of cinder and clay and was always rutted up. It was a real ankle buster. After running on the rubberized surface at the Comet Relays, where I ran my best times. I said someday I am going to buy a new track for Elyria Catholic. Unfortunately, someone beat me to it, so I realized I'd have to find some other way to give back some day. The desire to give back was just always in the back of my mind. It's part of our culture at EC."

After graduating, Krupelak joined the Air Force and it was during that time that he realized what a stellar formation he received at Elyria Catholic. "In the Air Force I got to meet guys from all over the country from all sorts of backgrounds and I realized, wow, I had it really good. My commanding officers said I stood out, in a good way. I credit that to my Elyria Catholic education."

Krupelak stayed in the Air Force for four years. Upon leaving he entered Lorain County Community College, earned his associate degree in computer programming,

and then entered the working world. Many years later he started to revisit the idea of giving something back to EC. While on Facebook one day he saw that Frances Schuster was receiving a Mother of the Year award at the Polish Club in Elyria. "Well, I knew the Schuster girls who were close to my age pretty well. There was Nancy '76, Mary Ann '77, and Jeannie '78. I was surprised at the story in the video. I knew that their mom was a single mother and that they had brothers and sisters, but didn't know any details. The details about their mother just really impressed me. This was an incredible lady. She had eight children and they knew if she wasn't home when they got home from school that she was either still at work or at the church volunteering. To raise eight children on your own and then find time to volunteer is truly incredible."

Frances T. Schuster's story touched Kevin deeply. He saw her unwavering dedication to her family, her community, and her faith as something remarkable. It was then that he realized that this incredible woman deserved to be recognized and honored for her selflessness. Krupelak continued, "After watching the video I just couldn't get it out of my mind how incredible she was and that this should be the focus of my gift. If you're going to establish a scholarship, well, this is a person, this is a life, this is an example that people need to see. People need to see grace and faith and what it can bring you through in life and what it can do for the people around you. Eight children. Great people. She set a great example for them. One Sunday I ran into one of the daughters at church and pulled her aside and presented the idea to her. I asked her to run it by her mom and siblings and to let me know. This was all about

honoring her and her life. It's not about me," Kevin explained.

The scholarship recognizes students demonstrating faith, grace, and service to the Catholic church – all qualities that Frances exhibited throughout her life. For Kevin, it was a way to pay tribute to the remarkable woman who had inspired his philanthropy.


The inaugural Frances T. Schuster scholarships were presented last spring during May Crowning. Kevin, Frances and several of her children were all in attendance for this celebration.

Kevin Krupelak's dedication to giving back doesn't stop with the Frances T. Schuster scholarship. He continues to be actively involved in his community, supporting various charitable organizations and initiatives. He believes that education and community service are the cornerstones of a strong and thriving society. "I was reluctant to do this story, but after reflecting I realized that I really do want Frances' story told as far and wide as possible. I hope she inspires others like she inspired me."

As for Frances T. Schuster, Kevin's gesture of setting up a scholarship in her name has left a lasting impact on her as well. She explained, "I was overwhelmed to put it lightly. Just speechless as my daughter Jean read a letter to us at our family Easter brunch. It said that a scholarship in my name was being started at EC benefiting students from St. Jude, all thanks to the generosity of Kevin Krupelak. I thought 'this isn't happening to me!' I never knew Kevin personally, only as an EC classmate of my daughter Mary Ann. I will never be able to thank Kevin enough for his generosity in honoring me in such a great way. He is really an example of a loyal and faithful EC graduate. Thank you, Kevin, may God bless you and grant you good health, peace of mind and wisdom of the Holy Spirit."

Faith is a powerful force that has the potential to guide us in every aspect of life. For Connery Van Dyke '19 and Issy Martin-Dye '21, their faith formation has taken them on an incredible journey that continues to inspire those around them. Through their involvement with FOCUS (the Fellowship of Catholic University Students), Van Dyke and Martin-Dye have been able to expand on the strong faith foundation they received during their years at Elyria Catholic.

Connery found his calling as a Focus Missionary at the University of Toledo. As a missionary, he dedicates himself to proclaiming the good news of Christ on campus and forming intentional relationships with students. Van Dyke recalls his time at Elyria Catholic as instrumental in shaping his faith and helping him discover his calling.

"At Elyria Catholic, I learned the importance of living out my faith beyond the classroom," Van Dyke shared. "When I started out at EC I wouldn't say that religion was my top priority. I focused much of my attention and time on my studies, cross country, track, bowling, and with the Boy Scouts. I credit Mr. Kronholz and his intellectual approach to religion with turning me to Christ. He genuinely cared about our spiritual growth and provided a logical pathway to accessing my faith."

During his time at the University of Toledo, Van Dyke was invited to attend mass by two other EC alums, Joyce Stupka '18 and Josh Horvath '19. There he met Branson, a missionary with FOCUS, who befriended him and invited him to a FOCUS event. One thing led to another and three years later it was, again, Branson who approached Connery about becoming a missionary himself. "I resisted at first, " said Van Dyke, "but it was through FOCUS work with another Toledo student when I realized what I was being called to do. I got the opportunity to invest in another student who was going through a tough time and worked through a 30-day Gospel reading challenge with him. This experience profoundly changed that student and he ended up leading a retreat. In reflecting on that I realized I needed to commit to the 3-year missionary commitment I was being approached about."

This fall, as one of FOCUS's 800 missionaries on campuses across the United States, Van Dyke will lead small group Bible studies, conduct one-on-one mentoring, and hold campus events. Van Dyke's presence on campus is sure to make a significant impact on many students, as he strives to provide an encounter with Christ.



Issy also credits her formative years at Elyria Catholic for inspiring her to further explore her faith in college. This past summer, she had the incredible opportunity to work as a donor communications creative content intern at the FOCUS Headquarters in Denver, Colorado.

Martin-Dye was active while at EC serving as class president all four years, playing volleyball, and being part of the gardening club and women's ministry. "For me, Elyria Catholic was a place where I not only received a top-notch education but also learned how to live out my faith in the world," Martin-Dye explained. "The strong sense of community and the emphasis on service at the school motivated me to find ways to continue growing in my faith in college." Interestingly, she also credits Mr. Kronholz, "EC was really good for me in getting into and understanding the faith through the theology classes, especially senior year with Mr. Kronholz. He led me intellectually to come to understand the truth of Catholicism, which changed the course of the way I now live my life in college. This deeply impacted me, for I don't know where I would be without his direction and the school's preparation for college." When she arrived on campus at Ohio University in Athens, OH she wasted no time getting involved with campus ministry. She explained, "By the end of high school I knew I

needed to go off to college and find Catholic friends. When I got to campus I went to the Catholic Center and met like-minded people who are still my best friends at OU to this day. I've volunteered with the Catholic Center and run their media." It was through her involvement with the Catholic Center that she was ultimately linked up with FOCUS for an internship this past summer. Martin-Dye's experience as a communications intern allowed her to witness the immense impact of FOCUS on campuses nationwide. By working alongside dedicated individuals who were passionate about their faith, she gained a deeper appreciation for the transformative power of encountering Christ in college. Martin-Dye stated, "Being part of the FOCUS Headquarters team exposed me to the behind-thescenes operations and the immense efforts put forth to foster a vibrant Catholic presence on college campuses. I am grateful for the opportunity to contribute to such a noble mission."



The first principal of Elyria District Catholic High School was Sister Mary Ralph, SND and the school was initially staffed by eight Sisters of Notre Dame and one layperson. All of these sisters held master's degrees and had specialized training in music, fine arts, manual arts, household arts, or physical training. Together, they served 245 students and offered a classical, general, and vocational curriculum. The school was approved and rated as a "First Grade School" by the State Department of Education with outstanding ratings in supervision and pupil attitude.
