REMINDER:

Counseling needs to know which college every senior will be attending so that a final transcript can be sent. If students will be engaged in something other than college such as military, full-time employment, etc., counseling will need to know what that may be.

Please bring to school on Thursday, May 4, your list of scholarships and grants. This list should include the actual financial aid letters that have been received from **any and all** colleges and universities. The Counseling Department will make a copy of the financial aid letters and return the original letter.

We will NOT ask for amounts of loans or work study—only scholarships and grants. Bring ALL the scholarships and grants that have been offered, not just the ones that are being accepted. These financial awards will be used at the Awards Ceremony and will be listed in the Commencement Program. The deadline for turning in scholarships and grants will be Thursday, May 4. Any questions should be directed to the counselors.

**Also, all seniors are required to submit scholarship information. If they choose to waive this requirement, they will need to sign a waiver which will be given to them, Thursday, May 4. If they do not waive this requirement and do not submit scholarship information, then the diploma will be withheld by administration.


 Appropriate dress styles (if uncertain, please check with Administration prior to the dance)

Doors open at 5:00 pm. Security will be taking tickets at the door. The ceremony begins promptly at 6:00 pm. No one will be permitted to enter while the graduates and the faculty are processing in.

The graduates will receive diploma covers only. Diplomas will be distributed in the James E. Terrell Performing Arts Center for 30 minutes following the ceremony. If not picked up then, they will be in the main office the following week.

The Coliseum will be open for 30 minutes after the ceremony for picture taking. After that time, we ask that you move out of the Coliseum so that it can be cleaned and locked by school personnel.
