FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION ... Friday, December 8 is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception and is a Holy Day of Obligation. There will be a 9:00AM Mass and a 7:00PM Mass at St. Patrick's and a 12:05PM Mass at St. Mary's.
