WELCOME BACK TO ALL OUR PARISHIONERS... We were pleased to see all who have come back and hope to see more of you as the week's progress. Even though there is limited seating, we are able to seat 91 parishioners in our church and 45 in our parish hall. Because of the low numbers who have come so far, seating has not been too much of an issue. Please keep in mind that as the numbers increase, it will be necessary for the assigned seats to be enforced so that the required social distancing is maintained. We also ask that everyone wear a mask. We hope everyone will understand and comply with the rules that are necessary so that we can remain safe and healthy.

NO FIRST FRIDAY AT EITHER PARISH ... Due to our parish restrictions at this time, we will not have First Friday Exposition and Benediction at St. Mary's or St. Patrick's.

STEWARDSHIP ... Many thanks to all who continue to support St. Patrick's Church with their offertory gifts, either by mail, personal delivery or when attending Mass. This is very important for the day-to-day operations of our parish. We are truly grateful for your continued support.
