Dear Ms. Polsinelli:

Per you request the following is a write up detailing changes in the civil design based on previous design plans vs approved plans.

- The previous design called for a single run of 190 feet of 96" aluminized steel pipe. The approved plan now calls for a dual run of 130 feet of 72" aluminized steel pipe.
- The previous design utilized a pump station to convey storm water to the existing on site storm system. The pump station has been eliminated in the approved plans.
- The previous design tied the storm water from the new detention to an existing catch basin within the parking lot area. The design now as approved will discharge the storm water via gravity to an existing structure within the Sly Drain easement adjacent to the West property line of the church property.
- The Wayne County outlet control structure has been relocated approximately 80 feet to the North of its previous location.
- Pretreatment units 31 and 32 were moved to the East, outside of the Sly Drain easement.
- Existing MH 23 within the parking lot was moved approximately 40 feet to the East.
- Proposed Hydrant 1 was moved approximately 25 feet to the North.
- Storm water profiles were updated to reflect the revised storm water design.
- A detail for proposed structure 29 (Drywell) was added to the plans.
- The North radius of the inbound lane for the entrance to the church has been revised to meet the Wayne County entrance requirements.

- Storm structure 30 was added to the approved plans.
- Approximately 80 feet of 12" C-76-CL IV pipe and 275 feet of 6" PVC Schedule 80 pipe were added to the approved plans.
- Wayne County details RS-1 and D-6 were added to the approved plans
- Changes to some notes and details have been revised within the approved plans.
