Sharing Our Gifts Through Outreach to the Needy

Giving Tree: Gift cards and donations collected totaled \$73,400 and were distributed to twelve organizations.

1st Sunday Food Drive: \$13,409 in financial aid was received in donations.

Blood Drive: 299 units of blood were donated.

Soup Kitchen: 4,390 meals were prepared and given out (average of 338 per month) at Saint Christine's.

Homeless Shelter: Along with the United Methodist churches in the area, volunteers shop, cook, serve, and provide Bingo prizes for 60 - 75 homeless people with over 200 meals served. (postponed due to pandemic)

Lenten Giving Crib: Donations of diapers, clothing, toiletries, and First Aid items were donated to two local pregnancy crisis centers. Current support has also been made through monetary/gift card donations.

Bell Ringers: \$2685.00 was collected for the Salvation Army by Saint Kenneth holiday bell ringers.

Christian Service Commission: \$226,101 in monetary assistance was sent to local charities.

Saint Vincent de Paul - Saint Kenneth Chapter:

\$20,888 was received in support. in support. \$13,224 was shared with other organizations. 114 food baskets for Christmas and Easter were distributed. 120 families received assistance with home costs: rent, utilities, gas and food. We sponsored two clothing drives.

Souper Bowl of Caring: \$4,235 was collected and sent to PB&J outreach.

Christmas in July: Over 800 tags generated much needed items for local veterans.

Coffee and Donuts: Offered twice each month. Approximately 210 attend weekly.

Lenten Fish Fries: Due to Covid restrictions, fish fry dinners were not offered.

Pancake Breakfast: Due to continued Covid restrictions, pancake breakfasts were not offered.
