

Catholic School Tuition Assistance Program

Our Parish Finance and Pastoral Councils have determined our parish should provide financial support to active parish families who send their children to Catholic Grade or Catholic High Schools. The specifics of our Catholic School Tuition Assistance Program are listed below:

- The Catholic School Tuition Assistance Program is NOT BASED on financial need. Rather, it is an opportunity for Saint Kenneth Catholic Community to support families who send their children to a Catholic Grade or Catholic High School.
- The Catholic School Tuition Assistance Program is open to all active registered parishioners who choose to participate. In order to apply the family must be registered and active at Saint Kenneth Catholic Community for a minimum of one year.
- Catholic School Tuition Assistance will be granted to families who meet the requirement of being actively engaged as parishioners by "Living the Gospel Sharing God's Gifts in Gratitude." Our understanding of stewardship is participation through: SPIRITUALITY, SERVICE, and SHARING.
- Catholic School Tuition Assistance will be \$1,000 per student enrolled in a Catholic Grade School (1st Grade through 8th Grade)
- Catholic School Tuition Assistance will be \$1,500 per student enrolled in a Catholic High School (9th Grade through 12th Grade)
- Catholic School Tuition Assistance will NOT be offered for Preschool, Kindergarten, or students attending a Catholic college.
- Catholic School Tuition Assistance grants will be sent directly to the Catholic School. One half of the grant will be sent in October; the other half will be sent in February.
- Catholic School Tuition Assistance forms can be found on out parish website or picked up at the Parish Office.
- Catholic School Tuition Assistance applications are subject to approval by the Stewardship Commission.
