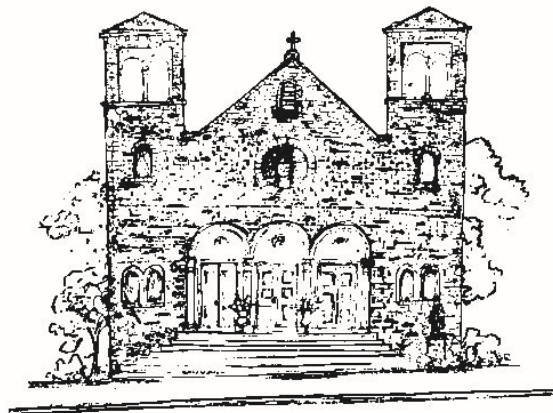

DAILY MEDITATION: ISAIAH 6:1-8

I saw the Lord. (Isaiah 6:1)

How would you feel if you saw the Lord? Amazed? Afraid? Even ashamed? That's what happened to Isaiah in today's first reading. He beheld almighty God, seated on his heavenly throne, with angelic beings shouting, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord!" (6:3). Overwhelmed, Isaiah cried, "Woe is me!" and confessed that he was unworthy to stand before the Lord (6:5). Peter had a similar experience in today's Gospel. Weary from a long, unsuccessful night of fishing, he was cleaning his nets when Jesus told him, "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch" (Luke 5:4). Peter must have grumbled as he cast his empty nets yet again. But once he saw the miraculous catch of fish, Peter fell to his knees, pleading, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man" (5:8). How wonderful that God didn't leave Peter and Isaiah in their fear and shame! Instead, he called them closer! God touched Isaiah and cleansed him of his sin. Even more, God invited him to speak to his people. And Jesus patiently reassured Peter, saying, "Do not be afraid," and welcomed him to join in his mission of "catching men" (Luke 5:10). He will do the same for you. Today, you have the chance to see the Lord—at Mass, as you ponder his word, or as you gaze upon the beauty of this natural world. In the brightness of his glory, you may become more aware of your darkness and sinfulness. But you will also realize that God is far more holy and loving than you have ever imagined. He will offer you his mercy and invite you to follow him more closely. Whenever you feel inadequate or afraid in God's presence, remember Isaiah and Peter. Don't allow those feelings to hold you back or paralyze you or make you feel disqualified from following Jesus. He loves you perfectly. He is so holy, so merciful, so good. You don't have to be afraid.

BLACK HISTORY MONTH

Black History Month is an annual celebration which commemorates Black Americans' achievements, honors their contributions to the United States and the world, and recognizes their crucial role in U.S. history.

Did you know that Six African Americans are currently on the road to sainthood? Please keep them in your prayers, especially during this month.

Venerable Father Augustus Tolton (April 1, 1854 – July 9, 1897) who the first Roman Catholic priest in the United States publicly known to be Black when he was ordained in 1886.

Servant of God Julia Greeley (1833-1848 – June 7, 1918) who was born into slavery, at Hannibal, Missouri, sometime between 1833 and 1848. Freed by Missouri's Emancipation Act in 1865, she joined the Secular Franciscan Order in 1901 and was active in it until her death in 1918.

Servant of God Sister Thea Bowman, FSPA (Dec. 29, 1937 – March 30, 1990) who was born in 1937 and reared in Canton, Mississippi. As a child, she converted to Catholicism. She joined the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration.

Venerable Pierre Toussaint (June 27, 1766 – June 20, 1853) who was born into slavery in Haiti. He became a freeman, successful businessman and philanthropist in New York City.

Venerable Mother Mary Elizabeth Lange (1784 – Feb. 3, 1882) who was the foundress and first Superior General of the Oblate Sisters of Providence
