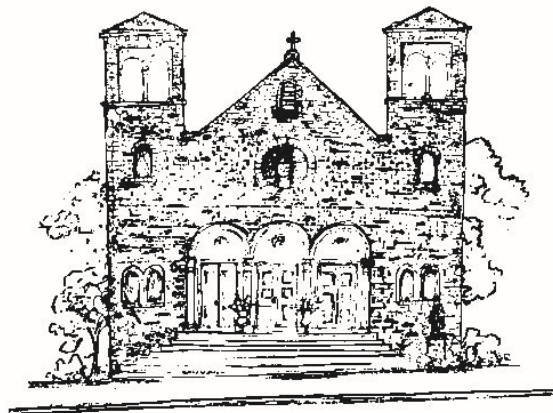

## DAILY MEDITATION: LUKE 21:5-19

In today's Gospel, Jesus provides a warning to his disciples. A time will come when there will be not only "earthquakes, famines, and plagues," but even the magnificent Temple will be destroyed (Luke 21:11). Their adversaries will hand them over to prison, their own family members will betray them, and some of them will even be put to death on account of his name (21:16). And yet, as frightening as his words are, Jesus assures them that "not a hair" on their heads would be destroyed (Luke 21:18). How could that be? Jesus' words make sense, both then and now, only if we look beyond this life to the next. He is promising that we will "secure" our lives for heaven if we persevere through hardship and struggle and trust in his grace no matter what comes (Luke 21:19). Then, when our life here on earth ends, we can look forward to the promise of living forever with our Lord. This promise can give joy and purpose to our lives even now. This life is what Jesus offered his disciples; that's why they left everything to follow him. Then, when he gave them the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, he gave them a share in his own resurrected eternal life. They knew that sin and suffering, death and desolation, no longer had the final word. Eternal life had already begun for them! This is the joyful witness of the apostles, martyrs, and all the saints. And it can be your witness as well, no matter your situation. So don't let today's Gospel frighten you. You can know the comfort of the Spirit and the joy of Jesus' victory today. You can stay faithful because Jesus will be with you in every circumstance. He will give you all the grace you need here and now, along with the sure and certain hope of eternal life in heaven.

You can trust in his loving care, now and forever!

## Parish Food Drive for the Capital Area Food Bank



With Thanksgiving approaching, we enter into a special season when we give thanks for the many blessings God has placed in our lives. But as Christians we are also asked to remember our brothers and sisters who struggle to put food on the table, especially in these challenging times. The government shutdown does not only affect directly those thousand of people who work for the government but also indirectly many people who are relying on so many government programs like e.g. the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly and colloquially still known as the Food Stamp Program, or simply food stamps.

This month, our parish is organizing a Food Drive to benefit the Capital Area Food Bank, which serves thousands of individuals and families across the Washington, DC area.

The Capital Area Food Bank is the largest organization in our region working to end hunger and provide access to nutritious food for those in need. Through the generosity of local parishes, schools, and community partners, they distribute millions of meals each year to children, seniors, and families facing hardship.

We invite all parishioners to take part in this important work of mercy. **Please consider bringing non-perishable food items such as canned vegetables and fruits, soups, pasta, rice, cereal, peanut butter, and other shelf-stable goods.** Every item donated helps feed a neighbor in need and reminds them that they are not forgotten.
