GUIDELINES FOR REOPENING ANNUNCIATION & ST. FRANCIS CHURCHES

Effective May 6, 2020

Masses will resume as follows on May 10, 2020:

Sunday: 8:30 a.m. at St. Francis

Sunday: 10:30 a.m. and 5 p.m. at Annunciation

Daily Mass at Annunciation: Tuesday, 6:30 p.m.; Wednesday-Friday, 8 a.m.;

Saturday, 9 a.m. You are encouraged to attend daily mass.

Confessions resume on Tuesday, 6 p.m. and Sunday, 4 p.m. at Annunciation; Sunday, 8 a.m. at St. Francis, or by appointment.

GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING MASS

♦ *So that Catholics do not feel compelled to attend Mass during the ongoing pandemic, the dispensation given by the Archbishop from the obligation for Catholics to attend Sunday Mass will remain in effect until it is safe to revoke it. Parishioners are encouraged to attend Mass at the parish in which they are registered or normally attend due to phased in density restrictions.*

♦ Persons with higher vulnerability to the virus, for personal safety reasons, are strongly encouraged to take advantage of the dispensation and refrain from attending public Mass.

Those Who Have Symptoms: Out of charity and concern for the welfare of others, anyone with any kind of acute symptoms, a fever or recent exposure to an infected person should not attend religious services.

♦ Please use prudence!

- ♦ Observe the 6 ft. minimum distancing requirements as noted in the church for entry, seating, and communion Seating will be restricted; ushers will guide you
- ♦ Masks are suggested to be worn throughout the mass Purify hands before entering and as you exit Please refrain from socializing after mass

♦ Other information:

- ♦ The church will be sanitized, but if you have extra sanitary wipes, please bring them with you and use when you leave church.
- ♦ If you have extra masks that you'd like to donate, please bring to the Parish Office.

This ordinance will continue through June 15, 2020.
