We Are Called...

This is one of the most precious and special days that we celebrate in our Church. It is the amazing Gift of God that we can have a participation in His Most Sacred Body and Blood. We may experience the beginning of the meaning of this, and possibly a few layers of the depth of this Gift, but how many really contemplate the truth of what transpires? Or that God prepares humanity for this Gift of prefiguring our celebration of the Sacrifice of Christ in the Old Testament with Abram and Melchizedek, King of Salem, and the sacrifice of thanksgiving using bread and wine. There is so much in this that we must glean, yet our ability is limited to take it all in. The sequence before the Gospel has layers of what we need to know, contemplate, and believe of the Gift that God shares with us. Here are a few parts of the sequence that are magnificent.

“This the truth each Christian learns, Bread into his flesh he turns, To his precious blood the wine:

Here beneath these signs are hidden Priceless things to sense forbidden; Signs, not things are all we see:

Blood is poured and flesh is broken, yet in either wondrous token Christ entire we know to be.

Whoso of this food partakes, Does not rend the Lord nor breaks; Christ is whole to all that taste ...”

The Gift that God shares is a participation in the unity of the Trinity. The Gift is a celebration of His sacrifice for our salvation. We need to understand the depth of this, because without it, we

cannot enter heaven once we know about it. He wants us to take part in all that He is offering. It is like going to a wedding feast and not eating or participating; we would offend the bride and groom. We would disrespect those who went out of their way for us by inviting and preparing for our presence. It is the Great Wedding Feast of the Lord! And He has invited us to take part in His Gift of Himself for us to have eternal life. How can we not take part and celebrate? We are called to live out in our lives the Gospel of John chapter 6, “That you will have life within you.” These are Jesus’ words, and they are Truth. We have spent two years learning about His Gift and are called to live it out in our lives.

We have offered books and book studies to bring our parish to a greater understanding and appreciation in the Eucharist. We sent ambassadors to Indianapolis to take part in the Eucharistic Congress. We want parishioners to grow in love of God by understanding what He did for us in giving His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity to us for salvation. We are responsible for responding to this Gift. Do you remember when we started this? Have any of the book studies affected how you participate in the celebration of the Mass? The Eucharist?

“We remember, We celebrate, We believe.”

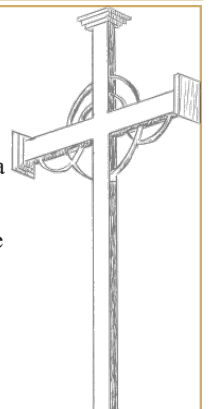

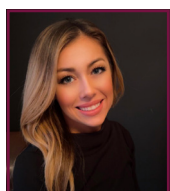
